BIOGRAPHY OF MR. ANTONIO OYARZABAL

Mr. Antonio Oyarzábal was born October 12, 1935 in Stockholm, Sweden.

In 1957 he graduated from the Law School of the Complutense University in Madrid, Spain. In July 1959 he entered the Spanish Diplomatic School and on June 2, 1961 he became a member of the Spanish Diplomatic Service with the grade of Secretary.

From January 1967 until February 1970, he worked in the Executive Office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He was then transfered to the Embassy of Spain in the United Kingdom where, he remained until June of 1974. Returning to Madrid he was promoted to the grade of Counselor and served in the Executive Office of the Prime Minister until July 1976.

After a few months as a member of the Forcign Affairs High Level Council, in December of 1976, the Council of Ministers appointed him Governor in Santa Cruz de Tenerife (Canary Islands), and in July of 1977, Governor of Guipúzcoa (Basque Region).

In May 1979 he became Assistant Secretary of State for Public Information and in January 1981 we was appointed Ambassador to Ecuador.

Upon returning to Madrid in July of 1983 he served as Secretary of the Joint Spanish-American Committee for Scientific and Technological Cooperation and Director of Bilateral Scientific Cooperation at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. In January 1986 he was named Assistant Secretary of State for International Cooperation.

From May 1990 to November 1994, he served as Ambassador to Japan. He was then appointed Ambassador to Denmark. In January of 1995 he also became Ambassador to the Republic of Lithuania with residence in Copenhagen.

In June of 1996 he was appointed Ambassador to the United States.

Mr. Oyarzábal has received numerous spanish and foreign honors and awards.

He is married to the former Beatriz Lodge. He has six children: Matilde, Marta, Juan, Gloria, Iñigo and Borja.
