IFC openly admits environmental shortcomings

THE INTERNATIONAL Finance Corporation (IFC), the largest private sector lender, has openly admitted its shortcomings on the environmental impact of projects and called for public comments on

its policy review.

In a 188-page document enti-. tled "Draft environmental, social and disclosure policies and review procedure," the IFC, which is the private sector lending arm of the World Bank, said its new/revised proposals "constitute a major step forward and reflect a serious attempt to address past short-

comings."

Over the past 18 months, the IFC has taken a comprehensive · look at its environmental and social performance, in an exercise which it called "at times, painful," and included independent review of one of the more criticised projects - the Pangue hydroelectric project on the Bio Bio River in Chile. In fact, the Pangue review,

the IFC conceded, "highlighted the need for decisive reform, clearer policies, effective procedures, and . the allocation of additional resources. TIFC has learned from the mistakes of the past and is determined not to repeat them," the overview says.

This is perhaps a historic first in the more than 50 years of existence of the International Bank Reconstruction Development, when an arm of the Bank has frankly admitted its mistakes and vowed to do something about them. It follows critiques from the environmental community of not just the World Bank but also its affiliate organisations such as the IFC and the Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA), as well as of the International Monetary Fund.

The main changes proposed in . the review include- Clarification of applicable policies and modification of policies of the World Bank . to apply more appropriately to a private sector lending agency's operations.

IFC NEW ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED

WASHINGTON, D.C., Mar. 12—The International Finance Corporation (IFC), the private sector arm of the World Bank Group, is undertaking a major reform of its environmental, social and disclosure of information policies. The objective is to enhance the environmental and social performance and demonstration value of private sector projects in which the Corporation is involved.

IFC released the draft policies for public comment on January 30, 1998 and set an original deadline for receipt of comments of March 20, 1998. At the request of interested members of the public who wish to express their views, IFC has decided to extend the comment period until April 17, 1998.

The policy reforms are the result of lessons from IFC's experience, feedback from non-governmental organizations and shareholder governments, and interactions with the Corporation's business partners.

Key changes in the proposed policy and procedure include:

- Clarification of environmental and social policies applying to IFC's work in the private sector;
- Increased focus on the social impacts of IFC projects;
- Greater emphasis on public consultation with parties affected by IFC projects, and local release of project information;
- Increased disclosure of environmental requirements associated with IFC financing;
- More practical treatment of IFC investments in financial intermediaries with an increased focus
 on environmental risk management training; and,
- Improved monitoring of projects in IFC's investment portfolio.

IFC is encouraging interested members of the public and the environmental and business communities to participate in the final formulation of these policies and procedure by commenting on the draft proposals - available electronically via IFC's internet website (www.ifc.org) and in paper copy from the World Bank's Infoshop. IFC will consider comments received through April 17, 1998.
