Caio:

We do indeed have an agreed action plan, and it is summarized in the letter and attachment to the GOA which is in the package sent to you. The letter is in Spanish, and I will be happy to have it translated if you think that is necessary. In any event, the key points in it are summarized below:

we have an agreed action plan for getting the works done up to what would have been required for 78m, even though the level of the reservoir is expected to be at 76m for the next 2 years at least; this has become necessary now that the 2 governments have decided to leave the reservoir at 76m for an extended period;

we also have emphasized the critical importance for successful and more credible implementation of the above plan, by saying we and GOA agree that we expect to be able to report favorably on the plan of action when we next go to the Board with the CAS and 2 loans, in mid-May;

GOA is extremely upset with the Panel's report which it believes has (a) not followed procedures, (b) is tendentious, and does not recognize any broader issues such as the tequila crisis, the presence of floods when the panel visited. It is also upset that a Paraguayan NGO is "using" the Bank to put pressure on GOA to handle problems in a binational project that are largely on the Paraguayan side. (This is not entirely difficult to understand since GOA and GOP have continued to have differences on the letter and the spirit of the burden-sharing arrangements between them.) GOA is expected to make a strong statement at the Board on Inspection Panel's report and lack of due process, while emphasizing that they have agreed with management on a plan of action and on the pivotal nature of Yacyreta in the Bank's assistance program in Argentina.

The gist of the letter is summarized above, but if necessary, will forward a translation of it to Javed's and your office by fax by cob today.
