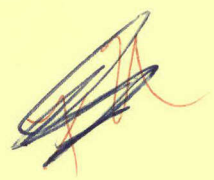

Dear Mr. Friedrich:

Thank you for your letter of October 13 and the enclosures which were most helpful.

You may be interested to know that from January 1 next the Provisional Regulations and Rules of the International Centre for Settlement of Investment Disputes will be superseded by a definitive version, and that the latter will in fact be available in pamphlet form in about a month from now. I imagine you would sooner distribute this to your members than the provisional version, and so unless you write to the contrary we will send you the definitive version in the quantities you require for English and French some time next month. A Spanish set won't be produced until a Spanish-speaking country joins the Centre. The pamphlets will probably go out by sea-mail from here.

Meanwhile I have asked our European Information Services to send you copies of the convention in the appropriate languages and quantities. These will be sent from our Paris office, which will save time.

I am sure your members will find these publications useful. They might also be interested in some other relevant booklets and pamphlets we are putting out which you probably have not seen yet. Anyway, I am enclosing a selection of these; if you think any or all of them are worth distributing, then we would be pleased to supply them.

You probably read in the Bank's Annual Report that the draft of the multi-lateral investment insurance scheme has been submitted to member governments and interested organizations for review and comment. All one can add to this at present, I am afraid, is that the executive directors here are still studying the draft - in fact a meeting was held on it this week, but there is nothing concrete to report as yet.

Dear Dr. Abbina:

I apologize for the delay in replying to your letter of December 11 to the International Development Association (IDA). It was held on the possibility that similar letters would be addressed to the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Finance Corporation, but you may already have their Articles of Agreement and By-Laws.

By copy of this letter, I am asking our European Information Services, presently located at 12, Rue de Presbourg, Paris 16e, France, to send you IDA's Articles of Agreement in English, French and Spanish. IDA's By-Laws are in English only; however, we can send you the Bank's By-Laws in English and French (there is no Spanish text of these); you will note that IDA's By-Laws were originally published with the By-Laws of the Bank as of November 30, 1962. The Bank's By-Laws have since been amended.

IDA's First Annual Report was for the fiscal year 1960/61. However, beginning with the 1963/64 issue Bank and IDA annual reports were combined. I am asking the European Information Services to send you the latest (fiscal 1966/67) in English, French and Spanish.

The European Information Services maintains a mailing list for publications and press releases in English and French. Headquarters in Washington send out any publications and press releases issued in Spanish for the Bank, IFC and IDA, and I am adding you to the list for them in Spanish, with the request that our European office address similar materials in English and French to you.

Since I do not know if our Translation Section receives your terminology bulletins already, please do not add us to your mailing list until I have been able to check this with them. The Publications Service is not the point within the World Bank Group which acquires publications of other agencies.

I wish to thank you for the 1966-1967 "Dictionaries and Glossaries," which I am sure will prove very useful to the staff.
