Legel Department - New Positions

This is in support of my memorandum of April 21 requesting two new professional positions and two new secretarial positions. The grounds for my request are as follows:

1. The staff of the Legel Department has not increased in proportion to the generally increased volume of Bonk work. Part of the additionel activity could be absorbed with the same number of lawyers since part of the work is of a more or less routine nature. However, the situation is now such that the lawyers have more work than they can hendle with suffleient attention and care. Furthermore, we need more time, especially the more senior lawyers, to review our own procedures. While we have done this to some extent, I feel that we should do more on such matters as amendments to the Loen Regulations and standard forms of agreement.
2. In addition to there being more work of the kind we heve been doing in the past, the work of the Legal Department in certain areas has recently becane for more burdensome. I refer in particular to increased activity in two flelds: (a) technical assistence, both under the UNDP Program and our own, and (b) increased work in Africa which requires lewyers who can handle French.
3. For many years the bulk of the Legal Department consisted of lawyers with considereble experience whose output wes high. While we still heve many experienced lawyers, we have in the last few years taken on severvi juniors whose output is not as high as that of their seniors and who require a good deal of supervision.
4. We heve been looking actively for replacements for Messrs. Pinto and Steckhan and have made offers to a number of candldates. Unfortunetely, these offers heve not been sccepted. Mr. Sassz, who holds one of our budgeted positions, is working full-time on SID. We are looking for a lawyer to replace him within the list of budgeted positions and we would like to recruit one more lawyer. Therefore, my request for two new positions means that we would like to hire four lawyers, two for the positions already budgeted but not illled and two for new positions. of these four, I would like at least two civil lawyers who can hendle matters in French or Spanish or both. I have no firm opinion as to where the other two should come from; that will depend on the way in which the work develops and on the eveilebility of candidates.
5. There is no lawyer in the depertment who should be replaced.
6. As for the secretaries, since each lawyer has a great deal of paper work, the efficient work of the deprrtment requires that there be one secretary for each lavyer.
7. We heve no office apace for the two edditionel lawyers and consequently we would need rooms for them both, as well as a room for their secretaries.
