Briefing for Meeting with Jim Wolfensohn in Washington on 6 June 1996

The theme for the meeting should be where CDC should work more closely with.

The World Bank.

1 CDC's distinguishing characteristics are -

- Total focus on poor and 'turning point' countries.
- 24 overseas offices with experienced, locally accountable country managers, principally but not exclusively in Commonwealth countries.
- Provision of management we manage 26 businesses and 15 venture funds employing some 40,000 people.
- With a single shareholder and a high degree of autonomy, we can
 move both quickly and flexibly.

2 CDC's potential role -

CDC supports and creates private businesses in the poorest and most high risk countries that have embraced the central role for the market economy. This is often most effective in the wave of pressure created by The World Bank.

Rather than talk in generalities it may be useful to take some specific areas where CDC is or could be a most natural partner.

3 Examples

Hub Power Project, Pakistan - The World Bank played a lead role in structuring this project as well as providing finance. CDC sought to add value through its experience in managing businesses in the developing world and providing an early commitment. CDC continues to work actively with The World Bank in Pakistan, and there are two major initiatives - Indus Grid and Port Qasim, where specific close cooperation at this time would be of great benefit.

Zambia - Under pressure from The World Bank, the economy has opened up significantly in the past three years. CDC has, in part through equity for debt swaps, become a significant equity investor and manager of businesses in Zambia. CDC is seeking to play a significant role in the privatisation of ZCCM. A full understanding of The World Bank's role in determining the actions of the Zambian Government and its direct role, if any, in the

rehabilitation of ZCCM, would be particularly welcome, as CDC's exposure to Zambia, relative to the size of that economy is among the highest.

The Cameroon Government appears to be at best, at a nascent stage in embracing the principles of good governance. CDC has some \$65m of arrears and originally provided the management for Camdev. We are keen to explore ways of developing a dialogue with the Cameroon Government to implement something similar to our role in Zambia, but recognise that this can only be achieved in the aftermath of efforts by The World Bank.

Venture Funds - by the end of 1996, CDC will be responsible for some 15 locally managed Venture Funds to assist in providing equity or quasi-equity for the SME sector. The challenge, for the success of these funds, is the development of local sources of medium term debt finance. Local development corporations tend to be inefficient and politically, rather than commercially motivated, while the private sector banking institutions are unwilling to take the risks involved. Are there areas in which The World Bank and CDC can co-operate to rectify this position?

SUBJECT: JDW/CDC

On June 6, JDW is meeting Lord Cairns, the chairman of the Commonwealth Development Corporation. CDC is a UK government-owned "IFC look-alike", though one which takes a more direct management role in companies in developing countries than does IFC.

CDC's chief executive, Roy Reynolds, has given me Lord Cairns' brief for the meeting for JDW's information (attached). CDC are looking for some specific partnerships to come out of the meeting - see item 3 of the brief - which may require a regional input to brief the President.

Lord Cairns (a hereditary earl) is chairman of CDC, and chairman of BAT Industries. JDW may well know him: he was at Warburgs for years, and CEO from 1991 until the SBC takeover last year.
