#### 1996 Awards for Excellence

#### Kenya Airways Privatization Initiative

The Kenya Airways Privatization Team has been selected for an Award for Excellence for its innovative and successful partnership between the IFC, the Kenyan Government and Kenya Airways which resulted in the first successful privatization of an African airline. The privatization team that was assembled included IFC advisors, representatives of the Kenyan Government, Kenya Airways management, private sector financial advisors, lead Kenyan stockbrokers, public relations and advertising firms, and legal counsel.

By maintaining a transparent competitive negotiation process, retaining a majority of domestic ownership of the airline, and assessing ways in which a wide representation of Kenyans could participate in the process, the team assisted the Kenyan Government and Kenya Airways management to attract a foreign strategic partner and convince Kenyans to invest in a privatized company. The result is a profitable, well-managed airline with a strong international partner, solid international and domestic institutional investors, over 113,000 individual Kenyan shareholders, and healthy employee shareholdership. This project has become a model of privatization for other parastatals in Kenya.

The partnership between the Kenyan Government, Kenya Airways and the Kenya Airways Privatization Team is a model of how open and well-supported communication between Government and implementing advisors can make the risky process of privatization possible and successful.

#### 1996 Awards for Excellence

#### Africa Road Maintenance Initiative

The Africa Road Maintenance Initiative Team has been selected for an Award for Excellence for its contributions to the development and implementation of innovative public participation and financing mechanisms in the roads sector in Africa. The team includes IBRD staff and consultants, other donor agencies, and country coordinators and associates.

By focusing on the issue of maintenance, getting road users involved in the system for managing roads, and encouraging governments to introduce explicit road tariffs linked as closely as possible to actual use of the roads, the team is helping to ensure the sustainability of the major improvements in the road system in Africa that are now being made. Many African governments have set up or are in the process of setting up road agencies and road funds, and are formalizing the role of road users as a result of the work of this team. Governments are also learning from each other and spreading the concept of commercializing provision of roads to other parts of the world, again as the result of the initiative managed by this team.

The Africa Road Maintenance Initiative Team is a tight-knit group of hard working and competent individuals who represent a very strong partnership between African countries and donor agencies, and who have emphasized working with all stakeholders - including the business community - to find indigenous solutions to the road maintenance problem.
