**AMBASSADOR PAULO-TARSO FLECHA DE LIMA
BRAZILIAN AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED STATES**

Ambassador Paulo-Tarso Flecha de Lima has been Brazil's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the United States of America since November 1993.

Before his appointment to the United States, he served as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the Court of St. James (1990-1993), Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary on a special mission for negotiations with the United States on economic and commercial matters of bilateral interest (1986), and as Special Representative of the Brazilian Government for Trade Negotiations (1986-1990).

On leave from the Brazilian Foreign Service, he served as Chief of Staff of the Government of the State of Guanabara (1960). He also was Secretary at the Brazilian Embassy in Rome (1961-1962), and Secretary and Deputy Representative of the Brazilian Permanent Delegation to the Latin American Free Trade Association (LAFTA), in Montevideo (1962-1966).

He began his career in the Brazilian Foreign Service in 1955 after receiving a degree from the Law School of the University of Brazil, Rio de Janeiro. He was a member of President Juscelino Kubitschek's staff from 1956 to 1959 and served as Director of the Latin American Free Trade Division in the Ministry of External Relations (1966-1968). From 1969 to 1971, he was Head of the Brazilian Government Trade Bureau in New York.

In 1971, Ambassador Flecha de Lima was appointed head of the Trade Promotion Department, at the Ministry of External Relations. Over the next thirteen years, he completely redefined, modernized, and expanded the services provided overseas in support of trade and investment. In 1984 he was appointed Under Secretary General for Economic and Commercial Affairs and, in 1985, he reached the top career post of the Brazilian Diplomatic Service, as Secretary General of External Relations. On several occasions, he served as Acting Minister of External Relations.

He has led several high-level Brazilian delegations abroad, and was Chief Executive for President Tancredo Neves's pre-inaugural trip overseas in 1986. He has been awarded numerous national and foreign decorations.

Ambassador Flecha de Lima was born in Belo Horizonte, Minas Gerais, Brazil, on July 8, 1933. He is married to Lucia Martins Flecha de Lima and has five children and two grandchildren.
