We realize that delegations will try to limit attendance beginning Saturday Sept. 24 ending Thursday, September 29. Nevertheless, wherever possible meetings should be scheduled for Friday. September 23 and September 30.

Otherwise, we can accommodate Part II countries in the following way:

Other Matters

- a) Mr. Conable believes, at this point, that it is not necessary for Mr. Qureshi to attend the press conference on 9/29. If anything special comes up during the meeting, we will let you know.
- b) BBC believes also that a Chairman-level meeting/luncheon with Commercial Banks should only be held if we have a specific agenda and purpose. He may however, wish to reach out to some Europeans and Japanese which will be decided as matters develop.
- c) Mr. Conable will attend the breakfast of the MDBs meeting on 9/25.
- d) He definitely does not wish to meet with top MOF Japanese officials but will have a meeting with Miazawa and has invited him to the G-7 lunch (his attendance has not yet been confirmed).
- e) There is no problem with Mr. Qureshi attending the meeting with the Germans and the British.
- f) The schedule for the briefing material is acceptable.
- g) The number and selection of countries are acceptable to Mr. Conable. He wants to make sure that Mr. Q does not feel that he has to attend each of these meetings but he should of course, be free to join if he so wishes. This I believe is in line with what you have suggested in your note.
- h) In case the conference center will not be open on 30th, we will make arrangements in Mr. Conable's hotel (Schweitzerhof) for appropriate meeting facilities. In any case, this strikes me to be the better alternative.
- i) Could you also pay special attention to the slotting of those countries which need interpretation services. Mr. C's experience is that these countries require at least 45 minutes. We could, for example, make sure we use the additional time available on Friday 23 and 30 where these is some flexibility to ensure we don't overrun. It would however, be very difficult to slot them into limited time on Saturday 24th or the morning of the 28th.
- j) The reasons we cannotwhy we provide you with more slots on the 25th as compared with earlier years, is because of BBC's involvement in MIGA activities and the special care he wants to take for his involvement in the African Caucus.

SUBJECT: Annual meetings. Follow-up to our recent discussion.

Marianne, I clarified a number of points with Moeen with respect to the upcoming Annual meetings:

.Moeen will attend the G-7 luncheon on 9/27(which he believes should be attended by all 4 SVPs) and the LAC Governors lunch on 9/24; he would also be prepared to join Barber for the press conference on 9/29, if Barber so desires(confirmation needed from you); naturally, he would join any other event for which Barber would like him to be present(you will let me know);

.the principal reason for not having a "Chairman level" meeting or luncheon with commercial banks is (as I told you at the meeting) that we do not have very much to say at this point; also, we do not expect all chairmen of the 10-15 major banks to be in Berlin;

.in Moeen's opinion, Barber should only attend the breakfast of the MDBs' meeting; we would then follow the same approach as last year, with Moeen staying for the plenary session and the lunch (you will let me know if Barber prefers to do differently);

.if something "special" is being arranged by Barber for the Japanese (an initiative that Moeen welcomes), it should essentially involve the top MOF off als(not a whole host of Japanese agencies ,banks, etc..), and take the form of a luncheon with a few Bank senior managers (you will let me know of the decision on this);

.Moeen would like to attend Barber's meeting with the Germans and the British (you will let me know if this poses any problem);

.instructions to the Regions for the preparation of country briefing notes along the lines we discussed-including the "issues-focused" update 1 week or so before the meetings- will be issued tomorrow; the deadline for submission of the briefs to us is Friday , September 2, and we should be able to review and forward them to you by Friday September 9 at the latest .The updates ("key issues to raise by the President") will be with you on Friday September 16 (please confirm that this is agreeable with you);

.Moeen suggests that Barber meet with the following countries: China, India, Indonesia, Philippines, Bangladesh, Algeria, Turkey, Yugoslavia, Pakistan, Egypt, Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, Colombia, Nigeria, Cote dIvoire, Senegal, Kenya, Zimbabwe, and Cameroon (i.e 20 countries in total as we had tentatively agreed); the RVPs will

be asked to react on this proposed list as part of the general memo on the Annual Meetings that we will send tomorrow(<u>I would appreciate getting your reactions on this list today</u>, if at all possible);

.For these 20 countries, there would be a single joint meeting with Barber and Moeen, unless the country makes a request for a separate meeting with Moeen beforehand or the RVP recommends it; in those cases where Moeen would hold a separate meeting, he would not join Barber for his own meeting (please let meknow asap if this arrangement is acceptable to the President);

.Since many delegations will not be in Berlin before September 23 or may leave before September 30 (especially the Ministers from large countries), we would propose that the slots for Barber's meetings with the 20 Part 2 delegations be allocated as follows:

-Sept 23 : 4 5 7 7 5 5 -Sept 25 : 3 2 -Sept 28 : 1 2 5 -Sept 29 : 1 7

Please give me your reactions on this load distribution (along with the exact blocks of time allocated for these meetings on each day) by the end of this week, so that we can work with the Regions on the entire planning for Operations. Thanks .Thierry
