Voluntary Contribution by New Zealand to IDA

New Zealand, which is not a member of the Association, proposes to make a voluntary contribution to IDA of NZ\$5,000,000* in convertible currency in five equal annual instalments. The New Zealand Government intends to pay the first instalment of NZ\$1,000,000 early in their next financial year which commences on April 1, 1971 and subsequent instalments in April of the succeeding years. It is recommended that the Executive Directors approve the acceptance by the Association of this contribution on the said basis.

In the absence of objection (which should be notified to the Secretary or Deputy Secretary by 12.00 noon on Monday, November 30, 1970) this recommendation will be considered approved, to be so recorded in the minutes of a subsequent meeting of the Executive Directors.
