To speed up the implementation of transmigration program to accomplish 1982/3 target of 125,000 KK as well as the carry-over of targets of previous years totalling about 75000 KK, the President has instructed that their settlement be completed by March 31, 1982.

Therefore the Provincial Governors/Chairmen of Satbin I are instructed to take the following measures:

- to improve further the coordination between agencies involved in the preparation of transmigration sites. a.o. the Public Works, the Provincial Government/Agraria, DGT, MOA, Communications, etc.
- 2. Land Clearing of houselots should take priority to enable immediate surveying and house construction. Clearing of LUs will take second priority. House and public facility construction contractors which have performed well (in the previous works) could be proposed to take on similar works; or land clearing contractors currently working on the sites under preparation could be proposed to under take the construction to of houses and public facilities.
- 3. notification that a site is ready to receive transmigrants should not wait until all the land has been cleared and ready for tilling/planting; clearing of the (reamining) land can be continued by the transmigrants themselves who will work and be paid by the land clearing contractor in line with the instruction of the Minister of Manpower and Transmigration/Chairman of Bakoptrans no. Inst./09/M/1980 dated August 4, 1980 attached hereto.

- Preparation of transmigrant settlements should be carried out in line with the instruction of the Director General No. 5 of May 26, 1981 (attached).
- The entire apparatus of Satbin I and II should understand and carry out the above measures to ensure the complete settlement of the whole 1982/83 target and carry-overs of the previous years by March 31, 1983.
