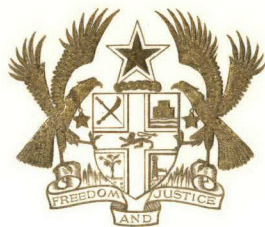

DRAFT OF THE SPEECH OF OSAGYEFO THE PRESIDENT
AT THE VALCO GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONY AT TEMA
ON DECEMBER 5, 1964

Mrs. May, Mr. Woods, Mr. Kaiser,
Your Excellencies, Ladies and Gentlemen,

I have great pleasure in participating in this ground-breaking ceremony to symbolize the start of the construction of the 115,000-ton Valco aluminium Smelter. We are today standing on the ground where a few years hence, flashing aluminium ingots will begin to flow from the large modern smelter to markets at home and abroad. It is gratifying to know that Valco and their sub-contractors have completed preliminary work such as leveling the ground, dredging the dock area, establishing workshops, a field hospital, housing accommodation and schools for their staff and that they confidently expect to complete the Smelter and to take power from V.R.A. by the scheduled date. I profoundly hope that the Smelter which will go up here will incorporate the latest design and technology and will be second to none in the world.

2. My esteemed friend Mr. Edgar Kaiser and his associates are slow to come by and tough on price, but what is most praiseworthy and commendable, is that they are tougher on efficiency and toughest in rendering full delivery of goods and full value for money on time. Let me express to you, Mr. Kaiser and all your associates including Mr. Calhoun who is unfortunately not with us due to illness, the warmest appreciation of my Government and myself for your outstanding collaboration and for the fine job you have done on the Dam and the Smelter projects. I would also like to take this opportunity to express our grateful appreciation to the Government of the United States of America and the Export/Import Bank without whose generous financial backing, the Valco Smelter would not have seen the light of the day.

3. What a contrast today's ceremony presents to a similar function at the Akosombo dam site in January 1962: The Volta dam and the Valco aluminium smelter project were then only a long-cherished dream and an aspiration. Today, the 260- foot majestic dam wall, the powerhouse installations, and the aluminium towers which dot the skyline around us have brought this dream nearer to fulfilment. My Government and I are happy to note that the V.R.A. now confidently hopes to generate power at Akosombo at the end of 1965. I would like to pay my tribute to the Consulting Engineers, the principal Dam contractor, the supply contractors and the V.R.A. for the efficient and conscientious discharge of their responsibilities for implementing the Dam project almost a year ahead of schedule. This function marks the beginning of the completion of the final phase of the Volta River project. The aluminium Smelter would provide an assured market for the Volta power and serve as a built-in safeguard for making the project viable and profitable. The Smelter will create new employment opportunities and impart technical and industrial skills to a large number of Ghanaians. When the Smelter reaches its full plant capacity, it is expected to bring a revenue of seven million dollars a year to V.R.A. as sale proceeds of the power supplied to the Smelter. This would help to service the loans given by the foreign Lending Agencies in the first instance, but eventually it would prove a source of strength to our foreign exchange position.

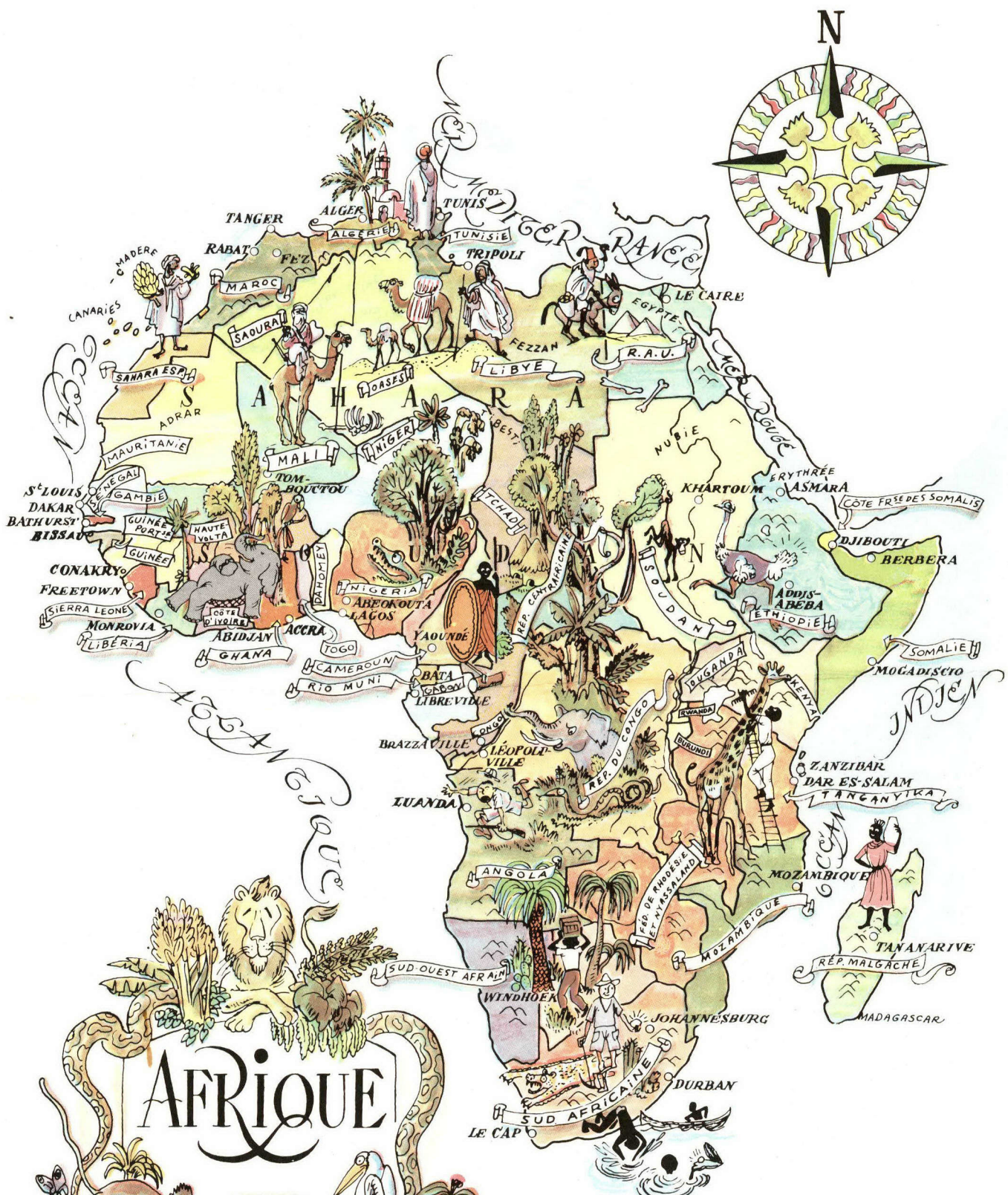
4. From the elevated ground on which we stand, I see the symbol of Ghana of tomorrow - a vast new industrial complex comprising of a modern port and new aluminium dock on our left; the cocoa butter plant, the new textile factory, the vegetable oils plant, the oil refinery and the new steel mill on our right, and the new hotel gradually rising on the horizon in the midst of a modern suburban township in the centre. The transformation of a relatively neglected minor port into a growing, thriving industrial centre within a short space of seven years is indeed a source of pride and encouragement for the future.

5. It is natural and proper that such a distinguished and illustrious representative of private enterprise as my friend Mr. Edgar Kaiser should have stressed the virtues of individual initiative and private enterprise. I should state categorically that no ideal is dearer to us in Ghana and in Africa than individual dignity and the development of the individual to his or her full potentiality. This is why we are passionately dedicated to the goal of the creation of a political, economic and social environment in which African individuality and personality will grow to their full stature. We recognise that our paramount task is to mobilize our economic potential fully and to maximise national production and income to assure rising living standards to all our people on a sustained and enduring basis. In this great task, private enterprise has a vital role to play, but our friends at home and abroad should recognise the formidable problems which beset our task.

On the one hand, in most advanced Western countries, political awakening and universal franchise followed the "Industrial Revolution" so that their economies were able to cope with the growing expectations of their awakened people. On the other hand, in Ghana in common with other less-developed countries, mass awakening and franchise have come before they had the opportunity and the time to rise above their economic backwardness. The 'revolution of rising expectations' of our awakened peoples presents a formidable challenge to our Governments and makes it imperative that 'speed' must be the watchword of the pace of economic development, and equalitarian distribution of expended production, the 'guide' to economic progress. Moreover, the very process of accelerated economic growth demands large-scale investments in infra-structure - roads, railways, ports, river valley schemes. These investments can be undertaken only by the public sector. It is evident that public sector has no less a role to play than private enterprise within the framework of our goals and policies.

The Volta Hydro and the Valco aluminium Smelter are a striking example of a happy blend of public and private enterprise. The Volta Hydro is the largest public sector undertaking in Ghana in collaboration with foreign Lending Agencies. The Valco aluminium Smelter is a contribution of two enlightened and reputed private Corporations in the United States. This common, cooperative endeavour clearly demonstrates that Ghana welcomes foreign capital, institutional or private, provided it comes without strings and with the sole purpose of helping to accelerate our economic development.

The growing industrial complex of Tema all around us emphasises that our task will begin, not end, with the completion of the Volta Dam and Valco Smelter. More urgent and pressing tasks await us for harnessing the potentialities of the Volta Lake, Volta Hydro and Valco Smelter for securing a rapid expansion of auxiliary industries, agriculture, fisheries and transportation. The Government and people of Ghana are determined to mobilise their own resources for this task, but let the word go from here, that Ghana welcomes understanding, fruitful and mutually beneficial collaboration from all friendly countries and international sources in the great endeavour of fully developing our economic potential and thereby strengthening the foundations of expanding world trade, prosperity and peace.
