

Joint Japan/World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program for Japanese Nationals

Next Call for Applications: February 12 - April 19, 2024

Award: A scholarship for Japanese mid-career professionals either admitted to, or currently enrolled in, a master or PhD program outside of Japan in an area of study related to development who are pursuing a career in international development. This scholarship will extend no more than two years and includes tuition, a monthly living stipend, air fare, and medical insurance.

Core Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Japanese national;
- Hold a bachelor's (or equivalent) degree, earned at least 3 years prior to the application deadline date;
- Prior to the application deadline, have at least 3 years of recent, full-time, paid employment acquired after receiving the first bachelor's (or equivalent) degree;
- Not be an Executive Director or alternate, staff, consultant of the World Bank Group or close relative or in-law of the aforementioned at the time of the application;
- Not be employed by the Government of Japan or its related agencies at the time of application;
- Not have received any scholarship funds from the Government of Japan for graduate studies;
- Be currently enrolled in or for the upcoming academic year have <u>by February 12, 2024</u> been unconditionally accepted (except for the condition of funding) into a master's or PhD program focused on a development-related area at a university outside Japan.

Application Process: The application guidelines, complete list of eligibility criteria, online application form and list of required documents are available on the World Bank Scholarships Program website

Applications must be submitted online by April 19, 2024 at 12:00 noon Washington DC time.

Up to 15 awards will be announced by June 2024 for the upcoming academic year.
