Annex 9

Characteristics of Research Included and not Included in External Research Program

- 1. The three main types of research <u>not</u> usually considered by the Research Committee involve studies that:
 - a. are of a technical or scientific nature, e.g., soils studies or feasibility studies, typically funded from Bank loans or IDA credits;
 - b. answer a country-specific or project-specific operational question even though they may involve the application of research methodologies previously developed (examples include architectural guidelines for education projects and computer materials for analyzing road and rail project alternatives);
 - c. involve core support to individuals and institutions outside the Bank on a "program grant" basis.

Such research is funded through discretionary budgets of Departments, as an adjunct to loans or credits, or from outside sources.

- 2. In contrast, research that <u>is</u> eligible for consideration by the Research Committee:
 - a. addresses socio-economic problems of development by formulating and testing hypotheses, using a variety of analytical techniques, in topics of sector-wide importance (small farm production, income distribution, water supply);
 - b. typically has a relatively <u>long gestation period</u>, permitting more comprehensive treatment;
 - c. is applicable to more than one country and therefore best funded from a general reserve;
 - d. uses "external" resources (consultants, travel, computing) requiring contracts with individuals or institutions outside the Bank;
 - e. is larger than some minimum size, currently about \$10-15,000 for "external" expenditures.







SUBJECT: Research Project "Grades"

> I attach herewith a set of tables and related information on the performance of research projects completed or nearing completion.

- You earlier received a breakdown by RPO expenditure of 127 projects in the research program (copy attached). In the present tables these projects have been classified as ongoing or completed. Of the 75 ongoing, 21 are "middle ground" projects, for most of which report writing is well advanced. Rating these projects is particularly hazardous. I can do no more than make judgment calls about them, based on what is known. You will note that for seven of these, insufficient information was available even to make a guess.
- More information exists for completed projects. Evaluation reports were, of course, the prime source for judgments about the 32 projects that so far have been subject to an organized evaluation. An additional eight projects have recently been completed and are scheduled for evaluation next year. Completion Reports were in the main relied upon in these cases, as they also were for the two projects whose results were absorbed in other ongoing research. Finally, when drawing up last year's list of evaluation candidates, we felt that for a number of projects, a formal evaluation would only reconfirm the obvious. These (with a few loners such as the country concentration exercise) make up the 10 "Not Evaluated" cases.
