1.	Regionalization of Social Protection	There is no affirmative action to provide assistance based on regional vulnerabilities	Develop social assistance distribution that considers the vulnerability of the life cycle, welfare levels, and regional vulnerabilities	CMHDC, MoSA, Bappenas
2.	Integration of Social Protection Programs	Social protection programs are not yet unified	Consolidate and integrate social protection programs with similar characteristics, whether in social assistance (non-contributory scheme) or social security (contributory scheme), to enhance access to livelihoods and decent work	CMHDC, MoSA, Bappenas
3.	Access and coverage	Limited access and coverage of social security participation (health & employment)	Expand coverage and accessibility of social protection programs, especially for vulnerable groups (informal workers and female workers)	CMHDC, Ministry of Manpower, BPJS Employment
4.	Energy Subsidy	Energy subsidies are regressive	Reallocate energy subsidies to promote more progressive, inclusive, and sustainable social protection programs to benefit and enhance the resilience of all citizens, particularly vulnerable populations, especially during life stages at risk	CMHDC, Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs, Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources
5.	Targeting of Social Protection	The National Targeting System is not yet integrated	Ensure the integration of targeting data using a unified and integrated system, particularly to guarantee the accuracy of social assistance program targeting, which will be incorporated as a Regsosek	CMHDC, MoSA, Bappenas
6.	Graduation of Social Protection Programs	The graduation mechanism of programs is not yet ready	Develop and agree on a Graduation System for Poverty Reduction Programs as a long-term solution	CMHDC, MoSA, Bappenas
7.	Adaptive and Inclusive Social Protection	Social protection is not fully adaptive and inclusive	Ensure the implementation of an adaptive social protection system that responds quickly to emergencies or disasters in the form of assistance, guarantees, or employment opportunities; simultaneously fostering an inclusive environment for vulnerable groups (through the care economy)	CMHDC, BNPB, Bappenas, Ministry of Women's Empowerment and Child Protection
