Integrated Land and Water Management to Support the NDC Partnership Plan




GRANT OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

This project enhances Namibia's capabilities for integrated landscape and watershed management. A member of the NDC Partnership, Namibia recently developed its NDC Partnership Plan with support from the World Bank, among other Implementing Partners. The project is aligned with this Plan and will contribute to the country's efforts in building climate change resilience and mitigating GHG emissions. Support is focused on key inter-related areas: land and forest restoration and sustainable management, climate-smart agriculture and water management, security and access. Analytical work and capacity building activities under the project include technical assessments and South-South Knowledge Exchanges. The project's work on the Namibia Climate Smart Agriculture Investment Plan is aimed at helping to identify bankable projects related to agriculture, landscape and watershed management. Project activities will use earth observation data to inform land management and water use decisions.
