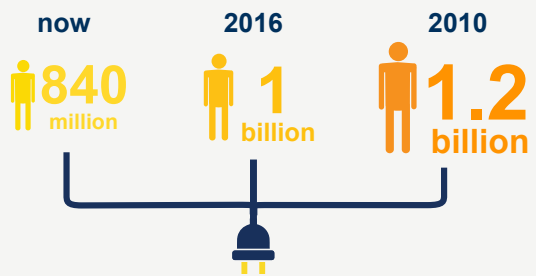


ACCESS TO ELECTRICITY (SDG7.1.1)

The world is making progress towards achieving universal access to electricity



The global electrification rate reached

89%



with **153 million** people gaining access to electricity each year

Progress has been uneven across regions; the biggest challenge remains in the most remote areas and in sub-Saharan Africa. Out of 840 million without access to electricity globally:



570 million live in sub-Saharan Africa

Under current policies an estimated

650 million

of global population will be without access to electricity in 2030

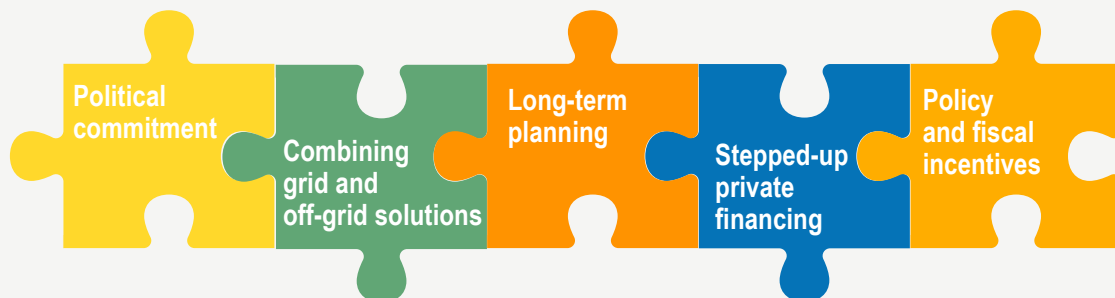
