

Dear Ralph,

To begin with, please forgive me for having waited so long with writing after you returned from your vacation trip via Japan...

After a rather quiet start during the first of our short stay in The Hague we have not seen much of our home. We had to spent quite some time in Arnhem because of the illness of Bep!s mother, then we spent almost a week in Staines UK with our eldest daughter and her family, almost a week in Copenhagen, and three days in Paris. In between we had a very busy time at our home and after all we had to rush in order to get everything organized for our departure.

In the first place I want to thank you very much for the numerous troubles you have taken to get a reasonable price for my car. I am very happy with the results ,with which I want to congratulate you and in particular also myself as you will understand. I am sure you also got my cable!

The remittance on the sale came through in the beginning of June, when I was in London. Anyway I am most happy to the money on my bank account now.

When in Staines Bep had a talk over the telephone with Dorothy, but we could not make it to visit them, in London. The Gamerons wrote us a few days ago that they are planning to buy a house on the South coast of England.

We also received a card from the Andersons in the Swarzwald Germany some time ago. I think everybody has settled down by now and I am sure Willye and you are happy to be home again after all the frustrations of the Calcutta study.

We just missed our youngest daughter and her family since their shipspas-sage had to be cancelled because of the middle-east troubles. They had to leave
Bombay exactly on the same day as we had to leave Holland for Rio. Could you
imagine?

For the time being we are staying in an hotel on the Copacabana beach, but we hope to shift to a residence next week. Weather is delightful and conditions here are uncomparable with those in India, or at least Calcutta. Much has improved in Brazil since we left Rio in 1964. The supply of information by the Government is very well organized and the study will be much easier than in Índia.

We hope to stay here until at least the beginning of next year. For the time being we plan to leave here in January/February for Kuala Lumpur.

Our address in Rio is: c/o Kampsax Caixa Postal 1836.

As for financial matters I noticed from your memoranda of June 2 and June 9
the payment of Rs 487.50 excess bagage and Rs 164.80 car repairs. However, I
did not find an item regarding the payments made on my behalf to the airport
restaurant in Calcutta when you were so kind as to releave us from the duty of
ordering drinks for our guests. Would you please let me know how much the damage is
so that I could square this out?

Before ending up I want to thank you heartily for all that you have done for us personnally during the long stay in Calcutta and for the fine atmosphere which you always managed to maintain in the team in spite of the many frustrations inherent to a study in the Eastern Region and in spite of your difficult position in between many "fires".

I hope this letter will reach Willye and you in an excellent health and that we shall meet again in Washington or somewhere else.

Dear Mr. Eschenberg,

In Mr. Watkins absence I am replying to a Memorandum of June 6, addressed to him by Miss M. Georgion entitled "Arrangements for Delivery of Cables after Hours".

In response to her 3 enquiries as follows:-

- (a) Cables addressed "TRANSURVEY, CALCUTTA" are delivered to the office at 8 Lindsey Street upon receipt at the Calcutta telegraph office, day and night, 7 days a week. When the office is closed telegrams are received by our guard and delivered to the addresses or the Mrector, if no addresses, when the office reopens.
- (b) No special arrangements have been made for delivery of cables when the office is closed. The cables received on Saturday might or Sunday are held by the building guard until Monday morning.

We have today made special enquiry at the Central Telegraph Office and suggest that the following procedure may be adopted by the Bank:

- (1) Ordinary Cables: which may swait regular office hours for handling should be addressed simply "WATKINS, TRANSURVEY, CALGUTTA"
- (2) Unrest Galles: that require handling when the office is closed should be sent "FS" (we understand this means "follow addressee") and should be addressed as follows:- "WATKINS, TRANSURVEY, OR 2 BALLYGUNGE CIRCULAR ROAD, CALCUTTA ". Under this arrangement we understand that the delivery will be tried first at the office and them at Mr. Watkins' residence, continuing alternately between office and residence until he is located. We suggest that this system be used sparingly since it means a good possibility of delivery in the middle of the night.

(c) We have suggested under (b) a method of cables requiring urgent action after hours. If you know that Mr. Watkins is absent from Calcutta (he normally advises you of M a proposed absence of more than a day or two), or for any other reason at your election, cables might be addressed If you feel certain that the cable will be received over the weekend, you might omit "TRANSURVEY" and simply address the cable to the residence of the designated staff member. Attached is the list of addresses and residence telephone numbers of the five staff members

Dear Mr. Eschenberg:

Now that only two and a half months remain until the completion of our assignment here, I think it is in point to ask for the Bank's instructions concerning the ultimate disposition of the Bank property which you have sent to us or which has been acquired here. 

SUBJECT: INDIA - Eastern Region Transport Survey: Replacement for Mr. Ziegler

- 1. We have known for almost four months that a replacement for Mr. Ziegler will have to be found in order to meet our commitment for assistance to the Eastern Region Transport Survey. I have been in contact time and again with Mr. Geolot and Mr. Eschenberg on this question. The last information I received from Mr. Eschenberg was that another likely candidate whom he had hoped to make available for this assignment had been placed elsewhere and that he could not forecast when a suitable candidate would be found and sent to Calcutta.
- 2. I think that this state of affairs cannot continue. As we know from the survey group's work program, Mr. Ziegler was expected to fully participate in the preparation of the survey. Mr. Verma, as well as Mr. Watkins, have asked us repeatedly for such replacement. The apparent inaction of the Bank in meeting its commitment makes it very awkward for us to ask the Indian side to meet theirs. We may find ourselves very soon in the embarrassing situation of being asked to extend the time limit for our assistance because among other reasons we had failed to supply a replacement. Whether this would be fully or only partly true is a different matter. It could in any case cast reflections on us.
- 3. I would therefore like to recommend urgently that a higher priority than hitherto be given to this assignment and that a man from outside be hired if the Bank is unable to provide a man within the very near future.

Dear Ralph:

- 1. Mr. Votaw wrote me about some of the matters you discussed with him in New Delhi. Here are the answers to your questions I have been able to obtain.
- 2. Hiring of local secretaries. This is really a matter for the Planning Commission to decide because it would pay the secretaries. The Bank has no objection to the study team hiring outside secretarial assistance and I understand from Mr. Eschenberg that he has so informed you.
- 3. Replacement for Ziegler. We had what looked like a suitable candidate but then his wife had a baby and that made an assignment to Calcutta inopportune. The search is going on. Both Warren Baum's office and Eschenberg are making all efforts to find a good replacement.
- 4. Representation costs. Your last letter was turned over to Mr. Eschenberg who told me that he replied to it. I have told him that you have not received his answer.
- Stay of the consultants in Calcutta. When calculating the cost of the Bank's contribution to the Eastern Region Survey, certain assumptions were made as to the length of stay of the various members of the mission. You, your assistant and the highway expert were expected to stay for eighteen months, the port and shipping expert and the railway expert for twelve months. Subsequently Mr. Harral has been hired for nine months. The letter agreement with the Government of India assumes that Phase II should be completed by the middle of 1966 but may take to the end of the year. We understood, when we discussed the progress of the survey in November, that all efforts would be made to complete it by the end of this year and the work schedule we received reflects this understanding. Our hope that this schedule would be adhered to was further enhanced by the fact that, in addition to Mr. Harral's services, you too have been able to devote more time to the study than originally anticipated. However, if you now have reason to assume that additional time would be required to complete the survey, or more specifically the Bank's assistance to it, could you let us have informally your estimate of who would have to stay on and for how long.

- 6. Consultation in Washington. We have nothing on the agenda at present that would call for your presence here in May, but if there are things you feel would better be discussed in Washington than in correspondence or during visits by staff members, please let us know.
- Temport Observation Mission to Japan. I remember you telling me that problems of rail/road coordination in Japan ten years ago were very similar to those prevailing in India today. Indian transport experts going on a mission to Japan might therefore benefit from Japanese experience. However, it would seem that your participation in such a trip would hardly fall within the scope of work assigned to the Eastern Region Transport Survey and the Bank would therefore find it difficult to meet expenditure incurred on that account from the funds made available for purposes of assistance to the survey as specified in the letter agreement. This is regrettable but I understand that the Japanese authorities can be relied upon to organize a good instructional program. Perhaps you could write to some of your old friends in Japan and advise them what aspects of their transport policy and coordination would be of specific value to an Indian mission.
- 8. The Bank mission's observations on the Eastern Region Transport Survey. You will remember that Hans Adler discussed in a meeting with the survey group the observations the mission had made during its visit. We thought that Mr. Verma and his colleagues had taken full note of it. Moreover, some of the points we made have been overtaken by events. It might nevertheless be a good idea to record them in writing so as to provide a checklist of things already done and things still to be done. I have written to Mr. Verma in that sense. A copy of my letter is attached for your information.

- 10. I trust these rather brief notes make sense. We can discuss any dubious points when I return at the end of the month.



This is in reply to your memo dated January 20, 1966, together with the original memo from Mr. Sundar Rajan.

The deposit of Rs. 428,00 made by the Government was established on the basis of an estimate prepared by the Bank.

> \$46,700.00 Post Allowance 28,750.00 Housing and Resettlement 10,000.00 Subsistence 4,550.00 Contingencies

> > \$90,000.00 = Rs. 428,000

The estimate was prepared in accordance with our usual practice of including only those items which would normally be paid by the Bank in the first instance. It did not cover all of the anticipated local costs since the Bank assumed the Government would furnish office space and equipment as well as clerical and manual personnel, etc.

If it is decided, that despite our earlier planning, the cost of the equipment, taxi hire, etc. are to be met from the deposit, the Government should be notified that the Bank may find it necessary to request a further deposit to meet the costs of the study.

Should the bills be sent to the Bank for payment, we would suggest that they be routed through Mr. Ralph J. Watkins, the Head of the Team, who will be in a position to verify the bills before payment.

1. We discussed the substance of the attached memorandum from Mr. Sundara Rajan yesterday over the telephone and I assume that you will initiate the necessary action.

2. I suspect that our team and/or the Planning Commission assumed initially that the deposit made with the Reserve Bank in our name was to cover expenditure for accommodation only. The text of the agreement, which is reproduced for your convenience hereunder, however, states that:

"The Government will bear the cost of all local currency expenditures incurred by the Experts in India for the Survey, including housing, subsistence, official transportation in India, as well as of office space and equipment and clerical and manual personnel. To that end the Government, upon confirming this letter, will pay into Account B of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development with the Reserve Bank of India at Bombay the sum of Rs. 428,000 which the Bank will use to meet such local currency expenditures. Additional amounts will be paid into the said Account by the Government at the request of the Bank."

3. I would be grateful for information on what action you will take so that I can advise Mr. Sundara Rajan. As a first step, it might be advisable to ask the Planning Commission to send all bills in this respect, paid or unpaid, to us. Please give me a ring if you want me to ask Mr. Sundara Rajan to get them for us.

Eastern Region Transport Survey Mission - India

- 1. Referring to the recent correspondence between Mr. Kaupisch and Mr. Watkins about the latter's representation allowance, I am passing this over to Mr. Eschenberg. These matters are the concern of the Administration Department and we should not take it upon ourselves to deal with them directly.
- 2. In Mr. Watkins' letter of January 7, he refers to various representation expenses which amount to provision of lunches and dinners for travelling Bank staff. While there may be occasions when such expense is unavoidable, generally Bank staff should not allow missions of the sort Mr. Watkins heads to incur representation expenses on their behalf. Bank staff members should pay for their own meals and cover the cost in their own expense accounts. One point to bear in mind is that representation expenses add to the cost of the mission, which may already be overrunning the estimate. In some cases also the representation expenses may be local costs which are borne by the Government. We had such a case recently with the Nepal Transport Mission. We should not meet mission representation out of Government funds.

- 1. Mr. Watkins has promptly reacted to my letter advising him of the limitations on entertainment expenditure. His reply is attached. The \$100 monthly limit is not cumulative so that Mr. Watkins would not be able to save up an amount against entertainment exceeding the limit.
- 2. I think that he has got a point in saying that it would not be possible in a number of instances to obtain the Bank's approval before invitations go out and we would certainly not like it if invitations were sent subject to the Bank's approval of the expenditure involved. The solution he suggests looks to me quite acceptable. If you agree, I will clear it with Mr. Reamy and write Mr. Watkins accordingly.
