## PROJECT NAME

Electrification of the Public Transport System

## GRANT OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The project supports Costa Rica's ambition to decarbonize its economy by fostering an enabling environment to scale up electric public transport systems. It has been instrumental in helping the Government form a multi-sectoral steering committee for the design and implementation of an e-mobility initiative. The committee brings together participants from the Ministries of Energy, Environment, Transport as well as private bus and taxi operators, financial institutions and electric utilities for knowledge sharing and decision-making. The project is also providing technical analyses on the cost structures of electric buses vis-à-vis conventional transport technologies, building the committee's capacity to identify financing sources and plan investments as well as design tariffs structures. Costa Rica has also developed an NDC Investment Plan with the support of the [NDC Partnership](#) with which it is aligning its fiscal framework for NDC implementation.
