Adaptation for Black Sea Coastal Zone




## GRANT OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The project aims to strengthen adaptation related components of Georgia's National Climate Action Plan to guard against the threats from sea level rise and extreme weather events in the Black Sea coastal zone. The Action Plan is based on the Road Map on Climate Adaptation produced in 2016. It formulates policy and investment actions aimed at minimizing the economic costs of coastline erosion, flooding, destruction of beaches and infrastructure, loss of biodiversity, and damage to public health and safety. The project also provides tools for climate-informed coastal zoning and spatial planning. Likewise, it supports the government, a member of the [NDC Partnership](#), in conducting an action planning process that is participatory and maintains a focus on the livelihoods of highly diverse coastal communities.
