Results Framework

Since 1960, the World Bank's International Development Association (IDA) has been building the foundations for long-term development in the world's poorest countries. IDA works together with client countries to tackle development challenges through a country-driven model that emphasizes ownership, alignment with national priorities, and improving the lives of the people most in need. IDA20 has adapted to a changing global context to strategically address critical issues, reflected in the five special themes climate change, fragility, conflict and violence, gender and development, human capital, and jobs and economic transformation, as well as the four crosscutting issues of debt, governance and institutions, technology, and crisis preparedness.

In line with the World Bank's evolution towards outcome orientation, IDA continuously monitors the results of the interventions it supports to understand the impact it is having in client countries and inform adaptive management. Through the IDA Results Measurement System (RMS) the World Bank Group tracks and measures how IDA inputs and activities help countries deliver tangible results that contribute to high-level development outcomes. The IDA20 RMS uses a three-tiered development results framework with 95 indicators to track results of IDA countries at an aggregate level. It represents the most ambitious results architecture in IDA's history.

² To ensure reliable regional and global poverty estimates, countries are required to have survey-based poverty data conducted within three years of the reference year, and regional estimates are only provided if they cover at least 50 percent of the regional population. However, during the COVID-19 pandemic, the extreme economic shocks and uncertainty prompted a shift in the approach. In 2020 and 2021, an annual coverage rule instead of a three-year window is used to decide on the regions for which to report post-2019 aggregates, such that only regions with sufficient data during or post-COVID have aggregates reported. Since, this special coverage rule is not fulfilled for all regions, the Bank is not reporting 2020 regional and global poverty rates.
