LEBANON REFORM, RECOVERY AND RECONSTRUCTION FRAMEWORK (3RF)

Context

- Launched in December 2020, the 3RF was designed as a response plan to address the urgent needs of the population affected by the 4th of August Port of Beirut explosion
- Goals:
 - Implement reforms to support reconstruction
 - help restore people's trust in governmental institutions by improving governance

Approach

Partnership between the Government of Lebanon, civil society, and the international community

Consultative Group

- Representative of the Government of Lebanon, donors, civil society organizations, and the private sector
- Enable coordination across actors and financial instruments, and facilitate linkages between the

Independent Oversight Board

- 6 civil society representatives (appointed through call for expression of interest)
- Independent oversight on 3RF implementation progress and use of financing and aggregating citizen perspectives

Impact

- The 3RF became an inclusive platform for policy dialogue beyond addressing the urgent recovery needs after the Port of Beirut explosion
- It focuses on the Implementation of reforms and the long-term reconstruction of critical assets, services, and infrastructure across all of Lebanon for sustainable economic development
