The International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), the International Development Association (IDA), the International Center for Investment Dispute Settlement (ICSID) (together the "World Bank" or "Bank", "we" or "us") respect your concerns about privacy. This Privacy Notice applies to the personal data [the Bank/ICSID] we collect and handle for the purposes of providing access to Development Partner Center (DPC) site. For the purposes of this Privacy Notice, "personal data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Information we collect during the registration/signup process.

Information We Collect by Automated Means

We obtain certain information by automated means when you visit this site, such as the IP address of the device you use to connect to the Internet and the pages accessed. By collecting this information, we learn how to best tailor the site to our visitors. We collect this information through various means, including "cookies" and "web beacons".

Like many websites, this website use "cookies" and "web beacons". Cookies are bits of text that are placed on your computer's hard drive when you visit certain websites. A "web beacon," also known as an Internet tag, pixel tag or clear GIF, links web pages to web servers and their cookies and may be used to transmit information collected through cookies back to a web server.
