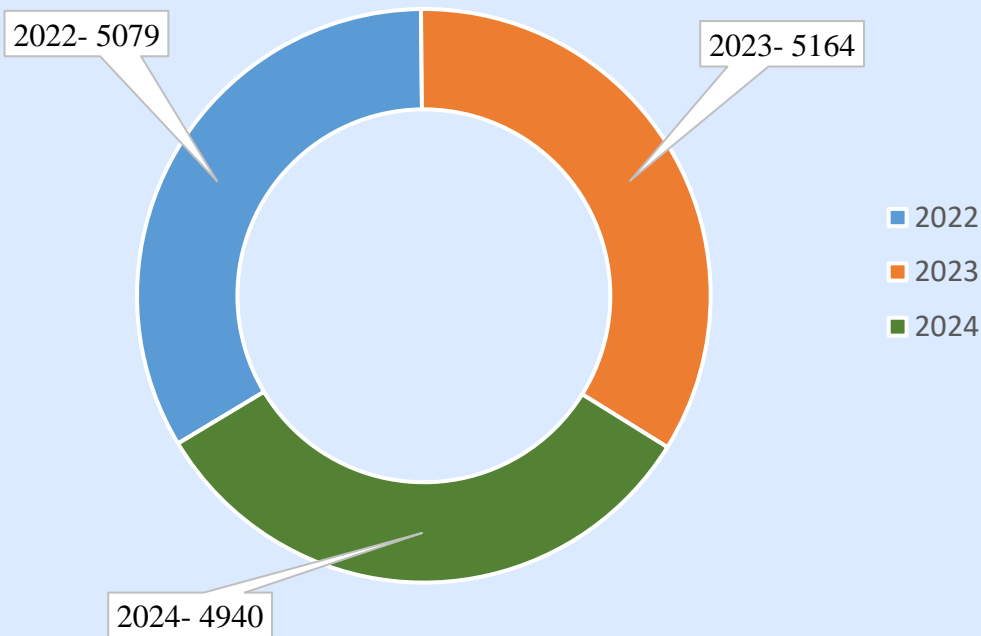

Around 4,000 micro-enterprises operating for more than 12 months

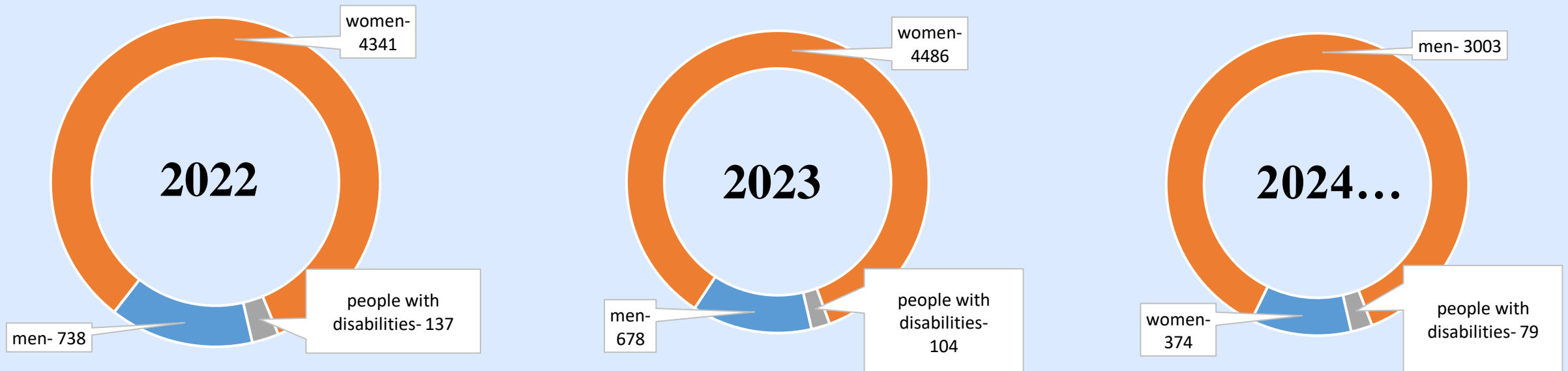

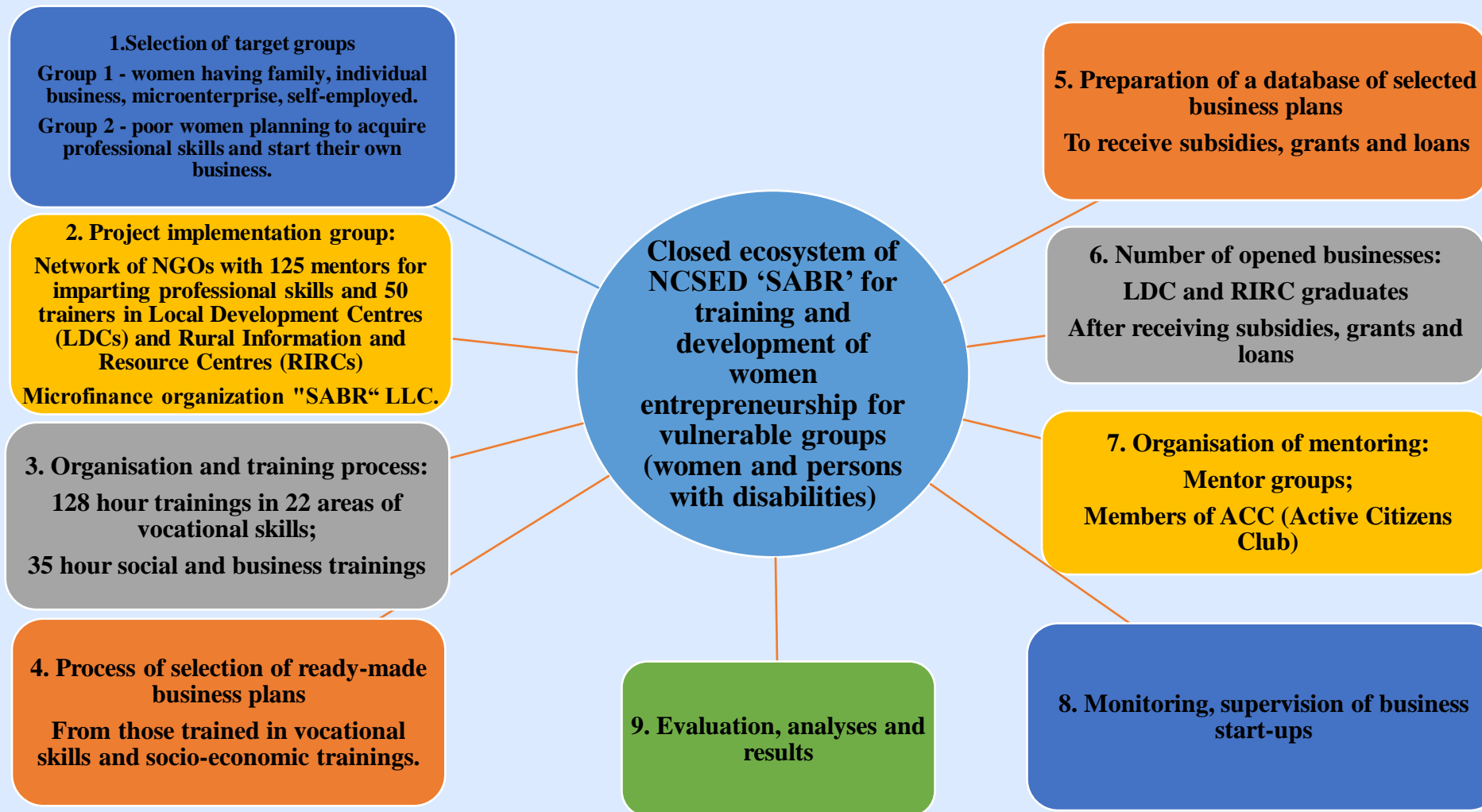
Gender structure
