- 3. Country-wide




For each of the three levels, several indicators of results were created and questions were designed to measure each indicator



The Results Framework and survey instrument were peer reviewed in 2016 by a senior IEG staff member as good practice



Similar Distribution of Alumni and Survey Respondents by Gender.


DISTRIBUTION BY GENDER

Similar Distribution of Alumni and Survey Respondents by Program Type.


DISTRIBUTION BY PROGRAM TYPE


What is your current employment status?


Type of organization you work for?



How would you grade the professional skills you gained through JJWBGSP-funded studies?



At any time since the completion of JJWBGSP, have you been promoted?



How many years after completion of master's degree did you receive a promotion?



To what extent do you attribute the promotion increase to JJWBGSP?


ATTRIBUTE THE PROMOTION TO THE JJWBGSP N=820

Did you receive any salary increase since the completion of your Master's degree?



How many years after completion of JJWBGSP did receive your salary increase?



To what extent do you attribute the salary increase to JJWBGSP?


ATTRIBUTE THE SALARY INCREASE TO THE JJWBGSP N=903




EXPANSION OF ROLE/RESPONSIBILITIES

To what extent do you attribute the expansion to JJWBGSP?


ATTRIBUTE THE EXPANSION OF ROLE/RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE JJWBGSP

To what extent do you believe your JJ/WBGSP- funded studies are relevant to your current (or most recent) work environment?


RELEVANCE OF JJ/WBGSP TO CURRENT WORK






COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE

In what ways have you shared the experiences and knowledge you gained through your JJ/WBGSP studies with others in your home country/region?






I was able to start up my own company with some of my classmate at University. Thanks to my acquired knowledge in Japan, my company worked with Japanese institution in infrastructure projects.





HOW MANY PEOPLE DO YOU EMPLOY N=200





If you start a new business or Civil Society Organization, what is the Nature of the work?


NATURE OF THE WORK N=200
