SINGA is an NGO that creates opportunities for newcomers and their host communities to meet and cooperate, including by supporting those with entrepreneurial projects. It incubated 211 organizations in the past 3 years in 6 European cities, and aims to support another 100 businesses in 2019. SINGA provides state-of-the-art support adapted to entrepreneurs' needs and goals, including networking opportunities, mentorship, workspaces, individualized follow-up, and workshops. Incubated startups are in various fields such as art, fashion, culture, technology, food, professional orientation, etc. SINGA enables inclusion through joint cohorts of newcomers (refugees, migrants) and locals, and by using collective intelligence to solve entrepreneurial issues. Entrepreneurs are presented as leaders and contribute to changing the narrative on migration.
