

## NaTakallam: Language courses & services by refugees and displaced people

<u>NaTakallam</u> is a for-profit social enterprise that offers high-quality language courses and services delivered by refugees and displaced people. The services include translations, online tutoring as well as cultural exchange sessions and other academic activities.

NaTakallam was initially founded to support Syrian refugees teaching Arabic, while it now offers language courses in Armenian, Kurdish, French, Persian and Spanish by refugees and displaced people from the Middle East, Africa, Central and South America. As of March 2021, NaTakallam had generated over \$1,000,000, connecting more than 10,000 users in 90+ countries.

NaTakallam has partnered with several prestigious institutions, including Duke University, Columbia University, Georgetown University and organizations such as the International Rescue Committee, Ben & Jerry's, and WeWork.
