Alexander Campbell - New Republic: Have never met him except on telephone.

Juan Cameron - TIME: Former Business and Financial Editor, Christian Science Monitor. Has been with TIME staff here for a number of years, and occasionally writes on World Bank Group. Has been helpful to us in establishing other contacts in Time-Life-Fortune organization.

Edwin L. Dale, Jr. - N.Y. Times: Succeeded me as Bank Editor, Herald-Tribune in 1949. Later covered banking for the Times in New York. Came briefly to Washington Bureau, thence to Paris as European economic and financial correspondent. Returned to Washington Bureau in 1963. Covers monetary and economic affairs and Governmental action affecting them. Is considered best in field. Is friendly to Bank and frequently writes on our affairs.

Robert Dietsch - Scripps-Howard Newspaper Alliance (Services Scripps Howard and other newspapers both domestically and internationally): Former Business and Financial Editor, Cleveland Press. Came to Washington about 10 years ago. Does some travel to report on economic and financial affairs abroad. Writes from time to time on World Bank Group.
