PROJECT NAME

Contribution of Landscape Restoration to Climate Adaptation and Mitigation

GRANT OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The project will support Tajikistan, a member of the [NDC Partnership](#), in identifying how landscape restoration contributes to climate mitigation and adaptation efforts. This process will be completed through a Restoration Opportunities and Assessment Model (ROAM) conducted by the World Bank. The ROAM is expected to complement an analysis conducted by the German Agency for International Cooperation (GIZ) on land use aspects and inform the agriculture section for Tajikistan's NDC revision. Through this modeling, the project will help identify restoration intervention types and feasibility in specific areas; measure costs and benefits for each; calculate the amount of carbon sequestered, and increase the ambition of Tajikistan's revised NDC. This project is being supported through the NDCP Climate Action Enhancement Package (CAEP).
