## GRANT OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The project supports adaptation actions to protect Côte d'Ivoire's coastal areas against hydro-meteorological risks. It is facilitating multi-sectoral dialogue between authorities and key stakeholders to plan and implement investments that contribute to coastal resilience. The project is also conducting technical studies and building the capacity of decisionmakers to develop an approach to protecting the coastal town of Grand-Lahou from erosion. Likewise, it is supporting the revision of the National Strategy for the Coastal Environment, with a focus on mainstreaming climate adaptation, disaster risk management and spatial planning.
