Household Consumption

HC survey carried out in Q1-Q4 / 2021

Machinery and Equipment

M&E survey carried out in Q3–Q4 / 2021

Construction

Construction materials survey for regional comparison carried out in Q3–Q4 / 2021. Additionally – the WB Survey «Construction and Civil Engineering», 2021 data – in Q3 / 2022

Non-market services and Housing rent – 2021 annual data are submitted by NSOs to the CIS-Stat



There are no changes in the **regional GDP classification for CIS ICP 2021** (regarding to 2017); it consists of 190 BHs.

A regional meeting to discuss methodological issues of GDP expenditures by BHs was organized in online format on December 12-13, 2022.

At the meeting a special attention was given to the data sources used for GDP compilation by BHs.

Submission of *preliminary GDP expenditures* to CIS-Stat was expected in April, 2023: 7 countries have sent the data in time; for 2 countries – the data are not available yet at the moment.

Submission of *final GDP expenditures* to CIS-Stat is expected in July, 2023. Validation of countries' GDP by expenditures: Q2–Q3/2023.



Household Consumption

The NSOs submitted annual average prices for 2021 to the CIS-Stat at the end of March, 2022.

The price validation was completed in January, 2023.

The final data for Global items as well as for regional items were submitted to the WB in April, 2023.

Machinery and Equipment

The NSOs submitted annual average prices for 2021 to the CIS-Stat in the end of November, 2021.

The price validation was completed in November, 2022.

The final data for Global items as well as for regional items were submitted to the WB in April, 2023.



Construction (regional approach RTM)

The NSOs submitted the price data on construction materials in Q2–Q3 / 2022.

The validation of price data was completed at the end of March, 2023.

The calculation of construction projects value for regional survey was carried out by a specialized consulting institution in April, 2023 (work being organized successfully thanks to the WB financial support)

Construction (WB approach)

Additionally, the NSOs submitted the price data (for 2021) on global items on «Construction and Civil Engineering» in Q3 / 2022.

The validation of price data was completed in April, 2023.

The data for Global items were submitted to the WB in April, 2023.

<u>Comments</u>: very poor specifications suggested for the WB construction materials provoke problems for NSOs' data collection.



Non-market services

The NSOs submitted the data in Q4 / 2022 – Q1 / 2023.

The data validation process is planned to be completed by the end of May, 2023.

Housing rent – Volume measures (quantity approach)

The NSOs submitted the data in Q4 / 2022 – Q1 / 2023

The data validation process is planned to be completed by the end of May, 2023.



2021 Household Consumption and Machinery and Equipment

Test PPPs by BHs were discussed at the regional ICP meetings (virtual) on March 1-2; and April 14-15, 18-20, 2022.

Checking and improving data quality – final PPPs – were computed in January, 2023.

2021 Construction, Non-market services and Housing rent – final PPPs estimations will be carried out in Q2-Q3 / 2023.

2021 GDP expenditures

Preliminary PPPs estimations will be discussed at the regional ICP meeting in June 27-28, 2023.

Final PPPs will be computed in Q3 / 2023.



The revised 2017 CIS ICP results were published in June, 2021.

All the detailed results are accessible at the CIS-STAT website in database format.

Revised 2017 PPPs and expenditures were submitted to the WB in May, 2022.

Currently, some updates for the Moldova's 2017 GDP expenditures are published.

A new 2017 revision is needed; it will be done simultaneously with the 2021 PPPs' computation.

September 14, 16–17, 2021 (bilateral): meeting of CIS-Stat experts with the Uzbekistan NSO experts on validation of Q1/2021 prices for consumer items

December 14–15, 2021 (regional): problematic investment items discussed, first validation of investment items prices

March 1–2, 2022 (regional): test PPPs for investment BHs were discussed

April 14-15, 18-20, 2022 (regional): test PPPs for HHC BHs were discussed

December 12-13, 2022 (regional): methodological issues of GDP classification for CIS ICP 2021 were discussed
