



## Joint Japan/World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program for Japanese Nationals

**Call for Applications: February 6<sup>th</sup> - April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

**Award:** A scholarship for Japanese mid-career professionals either admitted to, or currently enrolled in, a master or PhD program outside of Japan in an area of study related to development who are pursuing a career in international development. This scholarship will extend no more than two years and includes tuition, a monthly living stipend, air fare, and medical insurance.

**Core Eligibility Criteria:**

- Be a Japanese national;
- Hold a Bachelor (or equivalent) degree, earned at least 3 years prior to the application deadline date;
- Prior to the application deadline, have at least 3 years of recent, full-time, paid employment acquired after receiving the first Bachelor (or equivalent) degree;
- Not be an Executive Director or alternate, staff, consultant of the World Bank Group or close relative or in-law of the aforementioned at the time of the application;
- Not be employed by the Government of Japan or its related agencies at the time of application;
- Not have received any scholarship funds from the Government of Japan for graduate studies;
- Be currently enrolled in or for the upcoming academic year have **by February 6, 2023** been unconditionally accepted (except for the condition of funding) into a master or PhD program focused on a development-related area at a university outside Japan.

The completed application must be submitted online by **April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at noon Washington DC time.**

Up to 15 awards will be announced in June 2023 for the upcoming academic year.
