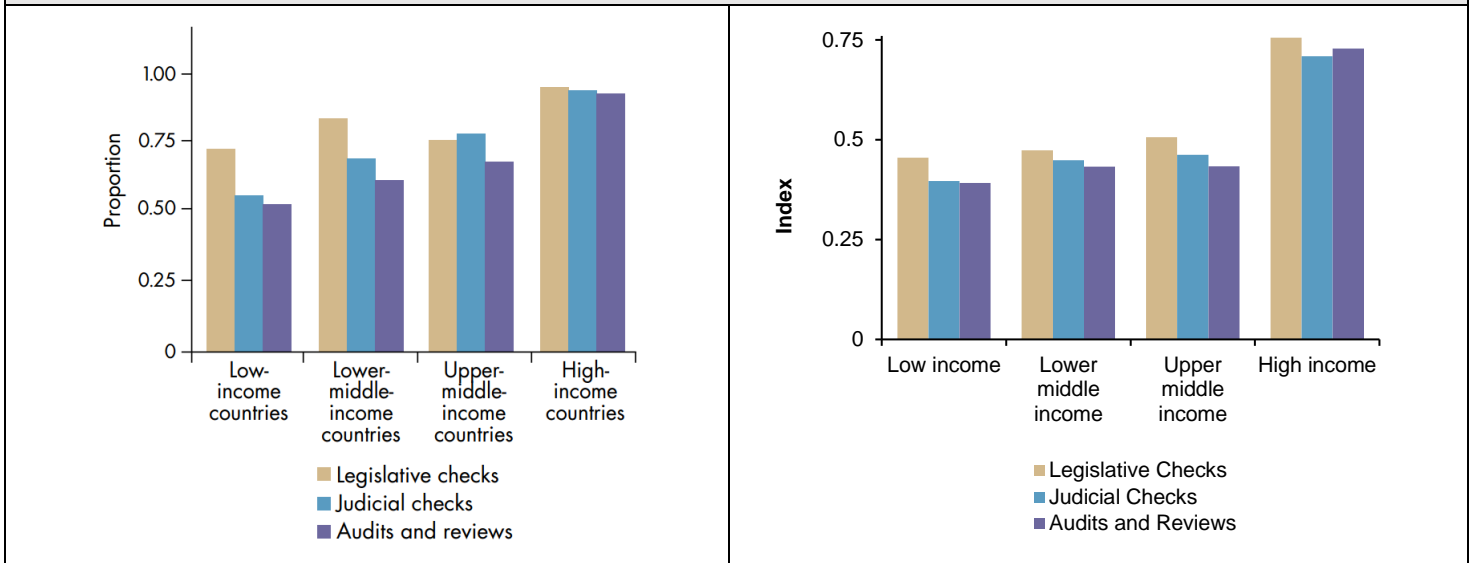


Figure 6.5 In some countries in the Middle East and North Africa, a large proportion of citizens believe that connections are as important as or even more important than professional qualifications in obtaining a government job (p. 176)

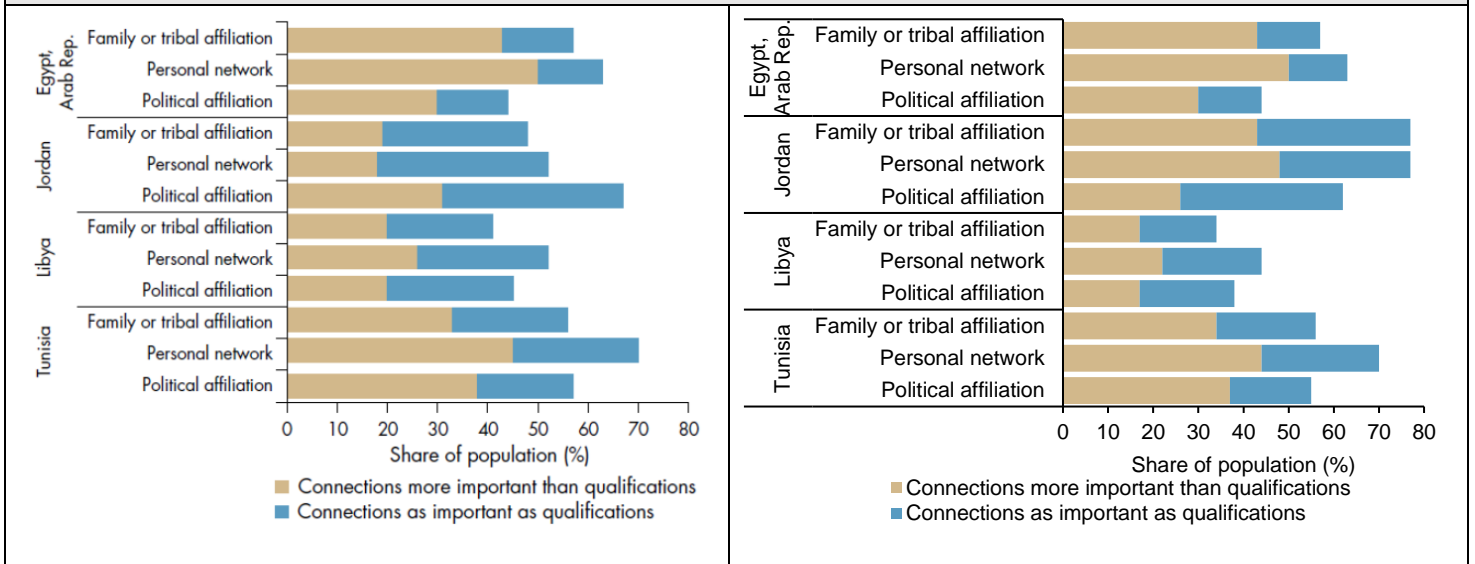


Figure S3.1: Although high-income OECD countries generally have well-functioning legal institutions, the relationship between institutional quality and income varies in developing countries (p. 103)
