Supporting the NDC Partnership Plan: Defining NDC Implementation Pathways

GRANT OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The project supports Honduras, a member of the [NDC Partnership](#), in defining pathways for implementing mitigation measures prioritized by the country's NDC Partnership Plan, a key document that defines the Partnership's engagement in the country. Key considerations in defining the pathways include- strengthening gender-related components, adaptation-mitigation synergies, inter-sectoral coordination among ministries and existing inter-institutional climate change committees. Additionally, the project aims to support the implementation of adaptation priorities in the water sector, by strengthening multi-level coordination in the country, linking national adaptation planning with local planning processes. Key activities include developing roadmaps for prioritized actions, identifying costs and potential sources of finance to provide inputs for a future climate investment plan and analysis of institutional and legal framework to generate recommendations to enhance NDC governance.
