Since she has been involved in monitoring and evaluating the IMF's anti-corruption work. Emilia coordinates TI's work within networks of Civil Society Organizations. She is currently a Steering Committee member of the C20, and she was recently chosen to be International Chair of its anti-corruption working group. Prior to joining TI, she worked for more than three years at Poder Ciudadano, the leading anti-corruption organization in Argentina and Transparency International's chapter in the country.

While the CSPF is an important space for civil society engagement with the WB and IMF, there is room for more impactful and effective interaction. Therefore, she wants to be part of the CSPF Working Group.

In Argentina, she worked as a Lawyer and as a Professor. Emilia worked with various national and regional organizations and networks over the years.
