SUBJECT: Uganda: SIDA-funded study on women's health

Thank you for helping draft the TORs for the SIDA-funded Study on Women's Health in Uganda, and for agreeing to back-stop the study during the next fiscal year. We look forward to your technical guidance on the substance of the study, so that the quality of the final product can be assured.

I expect you will need to review drafts of the study report in Headquarters in August-September 1993; and one of you might need to participate in a 3-4 day workshop in Uganda in the Fall when the report is discussed with Government. A total of about 3 staff-weeks of work might be required.

This task will be fully funded by SIDA, and will be undertaken by a foreign consultant, Dr. Karin Edstrom, whom you know (and who was on our March 1993 project preparation mission for the Community Health and AIDS Project). Karin will be assisted by local consultants from the Child Health and Development Center in Kampala, who will also be directly hired by SIDA.

Since the study is not an AF2PH Divisional product, we do not have a Task Number assigned to it for CAM purposes. However, I trust your own work program will allow you to devote the time and resources required for this important "operational support" activity.

I look forward to working with you on this Study, and to jointly preparing a HRO Working Paper based on its findings and conclusions. Best regards.
