

**COUNTRY ENGAGEMENT NOTE**

The Country Engagement Note (CEN) in Cambodia outlines the 2016-2017 partnership between Cambodian and the World Bank Group to support the government’s growth and poverty reduction strategy. The CEN’s objectives are to support the export driven economy, help the poorest and most vulnerable people withstand shocks by improving service delivery, and build their livelihoods.
