
Tuvalu

The World Bank's support to Tuvalu aims to strengthen road, maritime and air transport infrastructure, improve digital connectivity and education, and increase access to sustainable and renewable energy.

Transport



Energy

The Tuvalu Energy Sector Development Project is helping build the country's energy security by reducing its dependence on imported fuel for power generation. This work includes improvements to the efficiency of the country's electricity system, and by helping Tuvalu switch to at least 40% renewable energy.



Health

The Tuvalu Health System Strengthening Project is boosting access to primary health care in Tuvalu with wider community outreach for prevention campaigns, especially for non-communicable diseases.

Education

The World Bank is helping Tuvalu improve early education and literacy by engaging parents and communities, and by strengthening teaching quality and effectiveness at preschool, primary and secondary levels across Tuvalu.











Through the Tuvalu Telecommunications and ICT Development Project, Tuvaluans are expected to have faster, cheaper and more reliable internet. With support from the World Bank, new investments in a submarine cable are being delivered through a public-private partnership.

Economic Resilience

The World Bank is supporting Tuvalu's efforts to strengthen its public finance management, build the resilience of its infrastructure, and improve social protection and inclusion. Strengthen trade, and improve social protection and inclusion.
