Remarks by Mr. Clausen

**Farewell Dinner for
Mr. Shiv Kapur**

**Washington, D.C.
February 28, 1986**

Shiv:

Peggy and I are very happy to have you and Subira here tonight with some of your closest friends and colleagues. But we are all a little sad that the occasion should be to mark your retirement.

You have given some seventeen years of truly distinguished service to the Bank, seven of them serving our Latin American and Caribbean member countries; then ten years in the two highest positions in Operations Evaluation.

The Bank, as you know well, is a tough and highly selective recruiter to its staff. That's why we're a quality institution. Choosing a Director-General of Operations Evaluation is probably the toughest test of all. The Board looks for a person of wisdom, experience, integrity and, may I say, courage. All of these qualities are essential to this highly important and unique post.

That Hollywood immortal Sam Goldwyn once said:

"I don't want yesmen around me. I want everyone to tell me the truth about what we are doing, even though it costs him his job."

Happily, the Bank takes a more enlightened view of evaluation than Goldwyn did. And you, Shiv, have filled the post of Director-General with particular distinction. It is a far from easy task that the Director-General and his staff have to undertake.

You have carefully fostered and maintained the intellectual independence of your staff, and that is the very cornerstone of OED's credibility. There are few, if any, institutions in the world that can claim such an expert and impartial standard of self-evaluation. You have been a dedicated guardian of that tradition, and for that, the Bank owes you debts of both gratitude and admiration.

Might it be that a person born on the high seas makes a particularly good citizen of the world? You, Shiv, make the connection seem not at all fanciful. I know not whether the good ship "Maharajah" was steaming to or from India on that 22nd day of February, 1922, but you were not yet to be lost to the land of your fathers. You were eventually to give twelve years of distinguished service to India's Ministry of Railways. And maybe it appeals to the sense of history of one who has a Master's degree in that discipline from the University of the Punjab, that the Indian Railways you served are also a part of The World Bank's history, being the Bank's first ever borrower in Asia.

You brought with you to the Bank a wealth of planning and management skills. But you brought more than that. One of the true joys of our institution is that it is a rich assembly of cultures as well as skills. And I know how enthusiastically you have communicated to and shared with others here your extraordinary knowledge and love of India's art. You have talked about it, written about it, and actively promoted the work of contemporary Indian artists. No doubt many of those whose works are currently on view at the Phillips Collection's splendid exhibit are known to you, and have reason to be grateful to you for having been for so long an ambassador of art for your own country.

Now you and Su~~V~~ira will in time be returning to take up your life in Delhi. We know that you will plunge into that life with all the energy and enthusiasm that you have devoted to your years here in Washington.

There is an old Punjabi proverb which says:

"Fortune comes at random, but ploughing cannot fail."

You have ploughed well the good earth, Shiv, and have sown in it the seeds of your talent, wisdom and dedication. Many have benefitted from the harvest, for you served the cause of development most nobly.

We now wish you, Su~~V~~ira, and all your family, happiness and health. You leave behind a host of friends and admirers who hope to see you again in the future.

Good luck, and thank you, Shiv. We'll all miss you.
