DIF expands the scale and reach of evidence-based adaptive delivery, amplifying impact and creating opportunities to share lessons and shape practices across institutions. It provides financial and technical support to ensure development investments are not only well designed, but also dynamic and grounded in the best available evidence.

Projects are designed as adaptive, evidence-informed strategies:

- Embed proven solutions at entry
- Build in testable alternatives for future course correction
- Strengthen design to boost effectiveness from the start

Implementation is improved through rigorous learning and experimentation:

- Use A/B testing and behavioral insights to improve delivery
- Reduce delays and strengthen execution
- Increase impact through trial-and-adopt and build feedback loops to course-correct

### **SYSTEM-WIDE ENABLERS**

Scalable impact is achieved by creating the conditions for adaptive delivery and promoting smart replication, including:

- Portfolio-wide use of AI tools (e.g., <u>ImpactAI</u>) and real-time data systems (e.g., <u>MEGA</u>)
- Government support to establish data standards, digital systems, and enabling policies

This model makes development smarter, faster, and more scalable—ensuring that what works becomes the new norm.
