
















Country data submission: HHC 2019 – 2022





HHC: total coverage per Basic Heading by Country





Country data submission: Special Surveys 2021





Country data submission: Special Surveys 2021 (2)

- Consulting and TA (Construction, M&E, Government Compensation, Rental, Private Education)
- Rental: ECLAC estimates based on internet information according dwelling specifications (5 countries).
- M&E: Backcasting data:
 - Available data 2021 and 2022.
 - Challenge: Not all countries in the region have Producer Price Index (PPI)
 - Deflator to go from 2022 to 2021.
 - Use BLS data: USA M&E export price index 2022/2021.
 - Correspondence between HS and ICP items.
 - Adjustment of price index by USD/domestic currency exchange rate.
 - Outcome: M&E estimated prices for 2021 by country
- Construction: extrapolation/backcasting using construction price index or CPI(Caribbean)
- HOV: ECLAC estimates for 2021 based on Household Surveys information available at ECLAC for LA countries.




Country data submission: MORES

- MORES data for 33 countries:
 - 17 countries provided MORES for this Cycle (ARG, BOL, BRA, ECU, GTM, HND, NIC, PAN, PRY, PER, SLV, URY, ABW, BLZ, BMU, CUW, SUR)
 - Direct Approach (12 countries)
 - Extrapolation/Adjustments (5 countries)
 - Expert Opinion: 8 Caribbean countries were estimated by consultants (AIA, ATG, GRD, MSR, LCA, VCT, TTO, TCA)
 - 8 countries were estimated by ECLAC ICP team using the GDP figures and the approach "*Borrowing from Economy with similar structure*" (DOM, BON, CYM, DMA, GUY, JAM, KNA, VGB)



Extrapolation and Backcasting of prices for HHC



The CPI at the most detailed level available provided by countries was used to calculate factor in line with the item.



Validation process

Data processing and cleaning (*)

Definition of the 2021 regional list, review of specific Units of Measurement and Quantities (required and observed), maximum and minimum limits.

Analysis of results

Analysis of results obtained in the Quaranta-Dikhanov tables and complementary tools for data review



Analysis Process 2021

ICP - CPI Correspondences

Elaboration of code correspondences between the ICP (Item Code), and the CPI (COIPCOP Code) at the most detailed level for each country.



Execution and calculation of Quarantas and Dikhanov tables, Average prices in USD, Coefficients of variation (%), Index Price, Calculation of Parities






Calculation of factors and annual prices

Coefficient calculated from the CPI, generation of factors by Item Code. Q/A Factor - $CPI_{(2022/2021/2020/2019)}$




Exchange between focal points and national specialists, execution of macros in Excel spreadsheets, generation of validation reports, review of Coefficients of Variation (%) by Item







Annual average calculation of HHC prices



- CPI data maximum detail available by country.
- CPI coding according to COICOP based on country information primarily.
- CPI-ICP correspondence.
- Imputation of quarterly data with CPI throug Python algorithms (extrapolation and retropolation, depending on quarterly availability of information).
- Obtaining simple annual averages according to ICP methodology.



Price data validation

- Review of units of measurement.
- Review of the most critical cases in terms of their intra-country, inter quarters and inter-country dispersion.
- Websites review.
- Communication with countries to solve problems.
- Correction of cases and data submission to the GO.
- Special Surveys: Regional review
 - M&E Consulting (Planco Consulting): Benchmarks, review of outlier cases, consistency and validation process.
 - Other Special Surveys data validation: in progress



MORES data validation

- Validation process:
 - review of MORES data in relation to available national accounts data for each country:
 - GDP and components level
 - GDP and component structure
 - Basic heading with Price without MORES
 - Changes in structure over time



PPP estimation status

- Preliminary estimates using QT and DT tools at BH level
- Work in progress to include validated data on MORES and Special Surveys

ICP 2024 non-household pre-survey

- Proposal to incorporate additional details necessary for better comparability:
 - Rental: other costs included in rental amounts, such as parking or communal expenses in the case of apartments.
 - Private education: for language classes, recommendation to include only recognized institutions that allow access to a certification.
 - Construction and Machinery&Equipment: Verification of availability and effective use of items in LAC
 - Government Compensation: suggestion to remove firefighters
 - Household consumption:
 - availability of brand and/or model, for example telephone equipment, the mentioned versions are not available in LAC region, the same for mobile communication services, some of them are not available since the standards are of higher technology in terms of data and messaging is not part of the costs associated with the tariffs, among others.
 - Suggestion to remove cleaning services.



Challenges in implementing 2021 ICP Cycle in LAC

Financial and human resource constraints

Challenges of COVID-19 on statistical work:

- Lockdown and mobility restrictions
- Post pandemic (2021 and 2022) stores closure.
- Teleworking/Virtual vs in person meetings

Conduct of Census Round in the Caribbean region

Decline in participation of two countries (Barbados, Bahamas).

Delay in data submission in Caribbean countries

Natural disasters in LAC countries (Haiti, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines)

Delay in data submission due to staff changes:
Institutional commitment

Methological issues:

Inability of some Caribbean countries to elaborate the MORES because they do not have GDP measurements by expenditure approach.




Opportunities for improvement in implementing ICP in LAC

- Continuous communication with national focal points.
- Recommendations to countries to improve survey data collection and coverage.
- Capacity building activities.
- Assessment of alternative data sources.
- Sharing best practices in implementing ICP among regions.
- GO guidelines, recommendations and continuous support in the ICP implementation in LAC.
- Financial resources to improve ICP implementation in LAC and strengthen its sustainability.
