Goal: Ensure Data Integrity and Transparency of the Results

GLOBAL process

- Submission from the regions in the submission file format
- Regional focal points review the submission files
 - Upload to the database with fixes for formal errors (if any) OR contact the region in case of issues
 - Log on each submission and any fixes introduced (e.g. balance of imp/exp)
- Merged dataset shared for 1) Validation | 2) Calculations
 - Validation: Common findings
 - **Calculation**: Transparent and coherent results by the experts
- (!) Note: The outlined "formal" process requires sufficient time

 - Focal points (AFR: Maurice | ASI: Inyoung | CIS: Mizuki | EUO: Giovanni | LAC: Rui | WAS: Mizuki) will work with the regions to complete the sections

Governance: Governing Board Meeting

- <u>Recent meeting</u> in February 2023
- The next meeting was planned for the end of end-2023, as per the anticipated/scheduled release of the results
 - Q: Should we still try to schedule a brief (2h?) online meeting for December to brief the Board on the cycle's progress?
- Next physical meeting scheduled in conjunction with the 2024 UNSC
 - Sunday before the UNSC: February 25, 2024
- New Board for the ICP 2024 (traditionally following the cycles)
 - UNSD to issue invitations
 - Regional proposals?

Governance: Technical Advisory Group Meeting

- <u>Recent meeting held in December 2022</u>
- The next meeting was planned for the summer 2023, but postponed to November 2023
- Typically, the TAG has reviewed the results twice
 - Draft (usually HHC): "Spring meeting"
 - Semi-final: "Fall meeting"
 - ICP cycle 2021 is "one meeting behind"
 - Thus, another meeting may be required before the release (virtual?)

- Next round of global calculations from early 2024

Publication Level: ICP 2021

- ICP 2021 cycle suggestion
 - In general, maintaining the ICP 2017 publication level is suggested
 - New heading suggestion: "Total consumption expenditure" which sums
 - + households and NPISH final consumption expenditure
 - + individual consumption expenditure by government
 - + collective consumption expenditure by government
 - In total 44 + 1 = 45 published headings
- Note:
 - In some instances, the number of actually published headings varies depending on the indicator (example: reference PPP headings)

Publication Details: ICP 2017 and ICP 2021 (Suggested)

- 1. Purchasing power parity (PPP) (US= 1)
- 2. Expenditure (local currency units, billions)
- 3. Expenditure component share of GDP (GDP = 100%)
- 4. Expenditure component share of AIC (AIC = 100%) NEW
- 5. Expenditure per capita index, market exchange rate-based (US= 100)
- 6. Expenditure per capita index, market exchange rate-based (World = 100)
- 7. Expenditure per capita index, PPP-based (United States = 100)
- 8. Expenditure per capita index, PPP-based (World = 100)
- 9. Expenditure per capita, market exchange rate-based (US\$)
- 10. Expenditure per capita, PPP-based (US\$)
- 11. Expenditure, market exchange rate-based (US\$, billions)
- 12. Expenditure, PPP-based (US\$, billions)
- 13. Price level index (World = 100)

14. Share of global expenditure, market exchange rate-based (World = 100%) 15. Share of global expenditure, PPP-based (World = 100%)

PPP Time Series

- The ICP 2017 cycle introduced a new approach for estimating PPP time series between the ICP benchmarks
 - ICP 2017 cycle: revised 2011 2017 PPPs
 - ICP 2021 cycle: revised 2017 2021 PPPs
 - 6 published headings: GDP | Actual individual consumption | Households and NPISH final consumption expenditure | General government final consumption expenditure | Gross fixed capital formation | Domestic absorption
 - Only PPPs published, no other details
- ICP 2021
 - The ICP 2017 approach could be maintained, or the level of publication and/or the number of published details could be extended?
