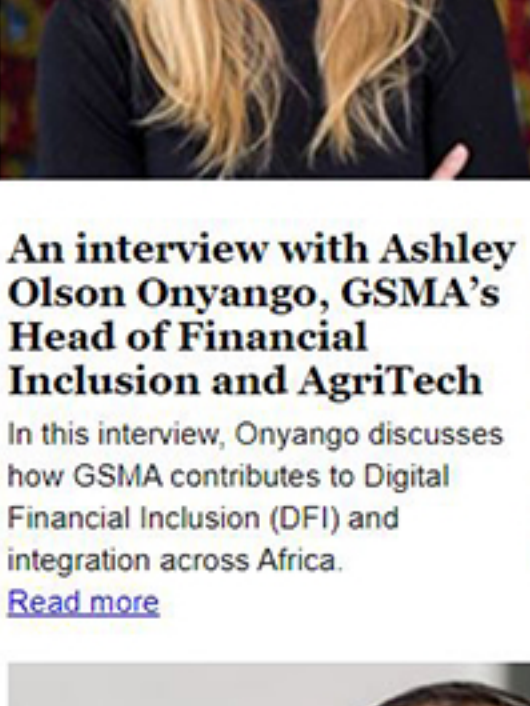

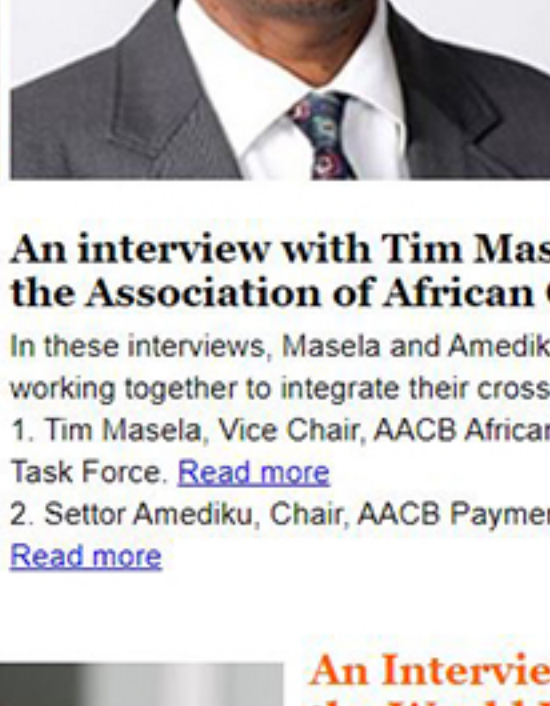
## FEATURED INTERVIEWS

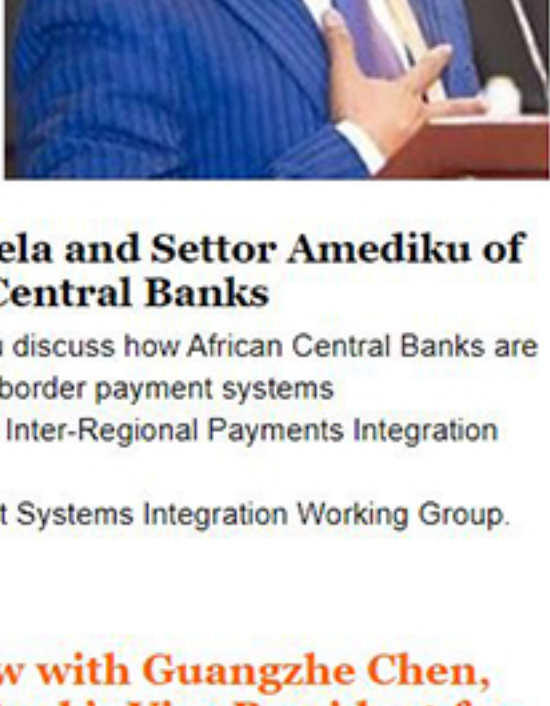

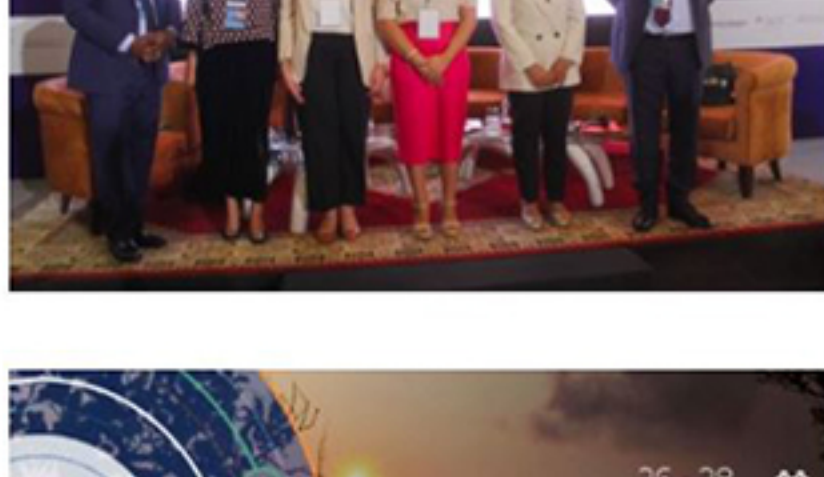

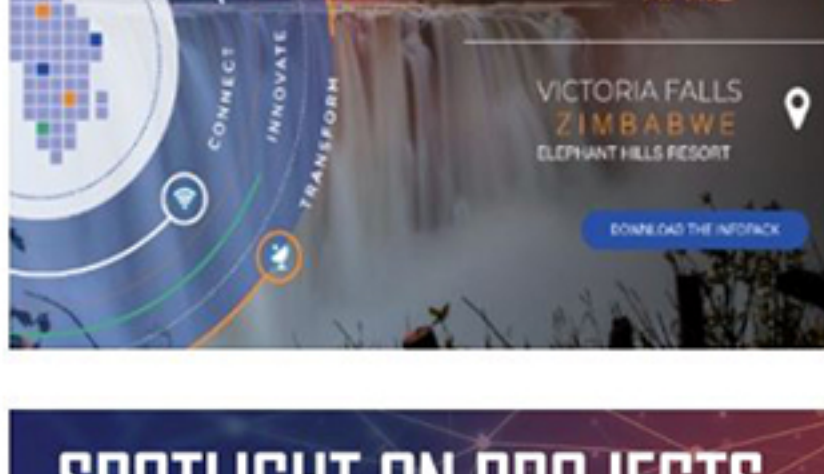
### Global Conference on Cyber Capacity Building (#theGC3B) in Ghana
