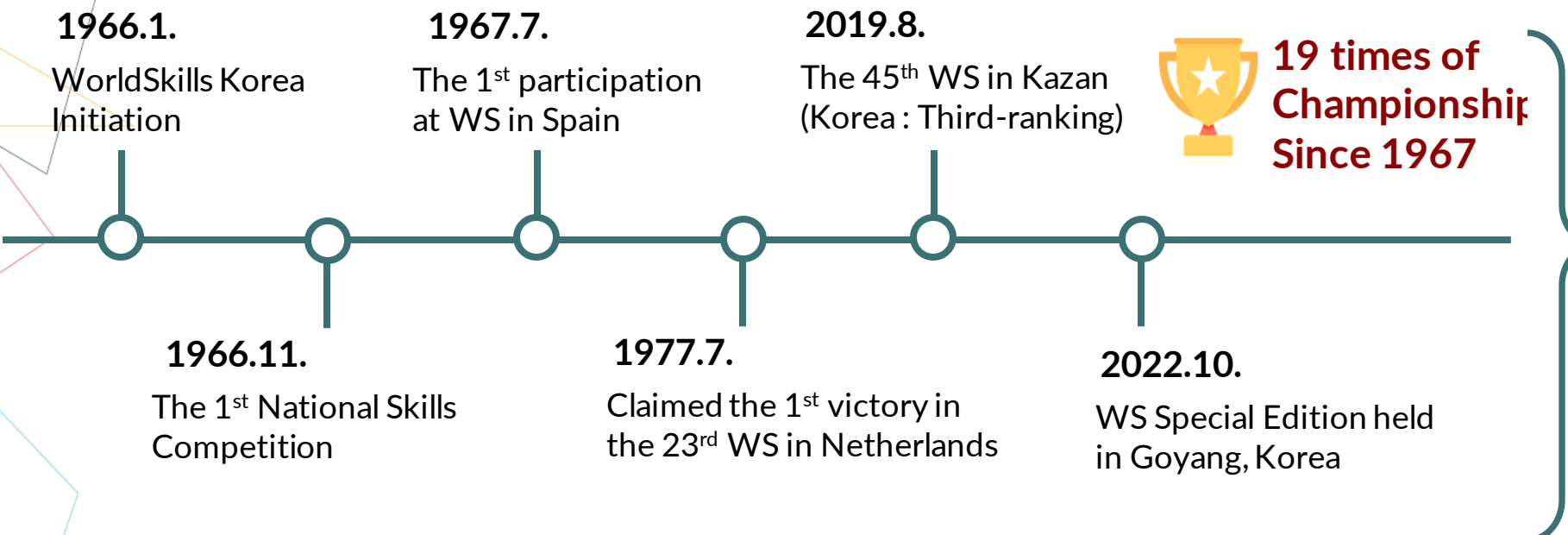

## Activities

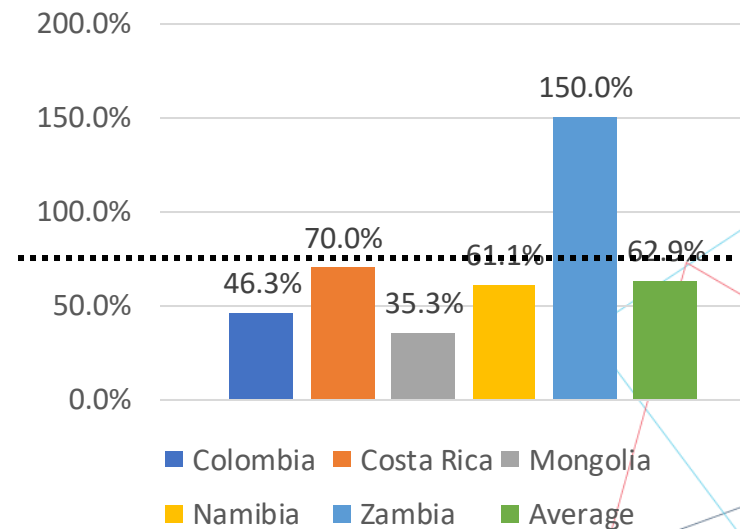
