# Country participation



## 9 CIS countries participate in full-size format in the ICP 2021:

The participation of Turkmenistan is not confirmed officially.



# Survey status



**Household Consumption** – all participating countries carried out the survey in Q1–Q4 / 2021

**Machinery and Equipment** – all participating countries carried out the survey in Q3–Q4 / 2021

**Construction** – all participating countries carried out the survey on construction materials for regional comparison in Q3–Q4 / 2021. Additionally, all participating countries carried out the WB Survey «Construction and Civil Engineering» in Q3 / 2022

**Non-market services and Housing rent** – the data compilation is in process

*Regional consumer items list consists on 2266 items*

*Regional investment items list consists on 584 items*



# Expenditure compilation status



There are no changes in the regional **GDP classification for CIS ICP 2021**

Regional GDP classification consists on 190 BHs.

A regional meeting to discuss methodological issues of GDP expenditures by BHs is planned to be organized in online format in December 2022.

At the meeting a special attention will be given to the data sources used for GDP compilation by BHs.

Submission of preliminary GDP expenditures to CIS-STAT is expected in April, 2023.

Submission of final GDP expenditures to CIS-STAT is expected in July, 2023.

Validation of countries' GDP by expenditures: Q2–Q3/2023.



# Data submission status



**Household Consumption** – all participating countries submitted annual average prices for 2021 to the CIS-STAT in the end of March 2022. CIS-STAT submitted the preliminary data for Global items to the WB in August, 2022.

**Machinery and Equipment** – all participating countries submitted preliminary annual average prices for 2021 to the CIS-STAT in the end of November 2021. CIS-STAT submitted the preliminary data for Global items to the WB in August, 2022.

**Construction** – all participating countries submitted the price data on construction materials on regional list (RTM approach) in Q2–Q3 / 2022. Additionally, all participating countries submitted the price data on global items on «Construction and Civil Engineering» in Q3 / 2022.

**Non-market services** – the data are expected to be submitted by CIS NSOs in Q4 / 2022 – Q1 / 2023. 3 countries submitted the data already.

**Housing rent** – Volume measures (quantity approach) – the data are expected to be submitted by CIS NSOs in Q4 / 2022 – Q1 / 2023. 5 countries submitted the data already.



# Data validation status



**Household Consumption** – price validation started in Q2 / 2022; checking and improving the data quality will continue by the end of December 2022

**Machinery and Equipment** – the price validation started in November 2021 and it is planned to be finished by the end of November 2022. Preliminary prices and first price validation were discussed at the regional meeting (virtual) on December 14-15, 2021

**Construction** – the validation of price data is planned to be finished by the end of December 2022

The calculation of construction projects value for regional survey to be carried out by a specialized consulting institution was rescheduled for Q1 / 2023

**Non-market services and Housing rent** – the validation of data is planned to start in Q1/2023



# PPP estimation status (ICP 2021 and revised ICP 2017)



**2021 Household Consumption** – test PPPs by BHs were discussed at the regional ICP meeting (virtual) on April 14-15, 18-20, 2022; checking and improving of data quality will continue by the end of December 2022

**2021 Machinery and Equipment** – test PPPs by BH were discussed at the regional meeting (virtual) on March 1-2, 2022; checking and improving of data quality will continue by the end of November 2022

**2021 Construction, Non-market services and Housing rent** – test, preliminary, and final PPPs estimations will be carry out in Q2–Q3 / 2023

The **revised 2017 CIS ICP** results were published in June 2021

All detailed results are accessible at the CIS-STAT website in database format

Revised 2017 PPPs and expenditures were submitted to WB in May, 2022





## Recent (all online)

December 21–22, 2020 (regional): meeting of experts of CIS NSOs and CIS-STAT to discuss reconciliation issues of consumer items list

September 14, 16–17, 2021 (bilateral): meeting of CIS-STAT experts with the Uzbekistan NSO experts on validation of Q1/2021 prices for consumer items

December 14–15, 2021 (regional): problematic investment items discussed, first validation of investment items prices

March 1–2, 2022 (regional): test PPPs for investment BHs discussed

April 14-15, 18-20, 2022 (regional): test PPPs for HHC BHs discussed

December 2022 (*regional*): to discuss methodological issues of GDP classification for CIS ICP 2021

December 2022 (*bilateral*): to discuss problematic consumer items and test PPPs for HHC BHs with the Tajikistan NSO experts
