Marshall Islands

The World Bank is working with the Republic of the Marshall Islands Government to address the significant challenges presented by climate change, sea level rise, and distance to markets. The World Bank is supporting Marshallese-led projects focused on climate resilience and disaster preparedness, renewable energy, skills and education, early childhood development, connectivity, and financial management.



The World Bank is currently supporting two Early Childhood Development Projects in Marshall Islands, totaling US\$30 million in investments to ensure Marshallese children are healthy, educated, and ready to thrive.

The projects focus on the critical first 1,000 days of childhood, through education and health home visits, boosting preschool attendance, and supporting vulnerable families with young children through social benefits.



Through the <u>Sustainable Energy Development</u>
<u>Project</u>, the World Bank is supporting the
Marshallese government to enhance the
reliability of electricity supply, improve
energy efficiency, and scale up renewable
energy generation in the Marshall Islands.
The project also supports long term system
strengthening for public health emergencies.



Environment & Natural Resources

The <u>Pacific Resilience Project</u> aims to help communities in the Marshall Islands better prepare for the impacts of climate change, through strengthening early warning systems, improving climate resilience and shoreline protection, as well as providing immediate and effective responses in a crisis or emergency.



Urban Resilience

The US\$30 million <u>Marshall Islands Urban</u> <u>Resilience Project</u> is working to improve climate resilience in densely populated parts of the atoll nation. This includes sea walls, dikes and embankments to protect important infrastructure in the capital.
