Access to education – low access for children in rural areas

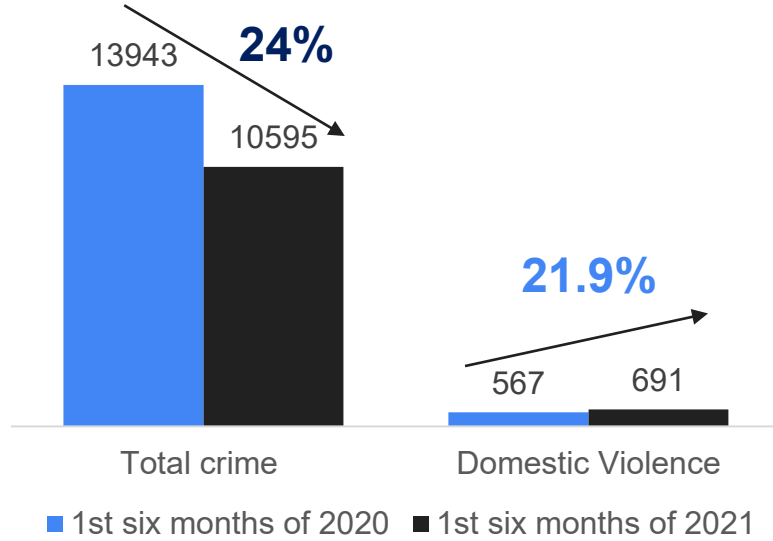


Access to up-to-date information and usage of IT *elderly and disabled people- low IT usage*
