Purpose of the Session

The purpose of this session is to review the current global item mapping for PPP aggregation, along with discussing potential new headings, with the objective of ensuring a shared understanding and agreement on the new mappings.

1. Review of Current Aggregation Mapping

Consistency in ICP classification between 2017, 2021 and 2024 cycles – they reflect both the COICOP1999 and SNA2008.

- 155 Basic Headings
 - 3 Special headings (GOV compensation without PAF)
 - 9 Construction sub-headings
- 126 Classes
- 62 Groups
- 27 Categories
- 5 Main aggregates

In addition:

- 12 non-hierarchical aggregates

12 Non-hierarchical headings

Code	Name	Description
9020000	Actual Individual Consumption	The total value of the individual consumption expenditures of households, NPISH, and government at purchasers' prices.
9060000	Actual Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas And Other Fuels	Household expenditure on actual and imputed rentals for housing; maintenance and repair of the dwelling; water supply and services related to the dwelling; and electricity, gas, and other fuels plus expenditure by NPISHs on housing plus general government expenditure on housing services provided to individuals.
9080000	Actual Health	Household expenditure on pharmaceuticals; medical products, appliances, and equipment; outpatient services; and hospital services plus expenditure of NPISHs on health plus general government expenditure on health benefits and reimbursements, and the production of health services.
9100000	Households And NPISHs Final Consumption Expenditure	The total value of actual and imputed final consumption expenditures incurred by households and NPISHs on individual goods and services. It also includes expenditures on individual goods and services sold at prices that are not economically significant.

Code	Name	Description
9110000	Actual Recreation And Culture	Household expenditure on audiovisual, photographic, and information processing equipment; other major durables for recreation and culture; other recreational items and equipment; gardens and pets; recreational and cultural services; newspapers, books, and stationery; and package holidays plus expenditure by NPISHs on recreation and culture plus general government expenditure on recreation and culture
9120000	Actual Education	Household expenditure on pre-primary, primary, secondary, postsecondary, and tertiary education plus expenditure by NPISHs on education plus general government expenditure on education benefits and reimbursements and the production of education services.
9130000	Total Housing	Household expenditure on actual and imputed rent, plus expenditure by NPISH on housing plus individual government expenditure on housing
9140000	Actual Miscellaneous Goods And Services	Household expenditure on personal care, personal effects, social protection, insurance, and financial and other services plus expenditure by NPISHs on social protection and other services plus general government expenditure on social protection.

Code	Name	Description
9250000	Domestic Absorption	Actual individual consumption at purchasers' prices plus collective consumption expenditure by government at purchasers' prices plus gross capital formation at purchasers' prices.
9260000	Individual Consumption Expenditure By Households Without Housing	The total value of actual and imputed final consumption expenditures incurred by households and NPISHs on individual goods and services, without housing related expenditures. It also includes expenditures on individual goods and services sold at prices that are not economically significant.
9270000	General Government Final Consumption Expenditure	The total value of actual and imputed final consumption expenditures incurred by government on individual goods and services and final consumption expenditure of government on collective goods and services.
9280000	Total Consumption (new for ICP 2021 cycle)	The total value of actual and imputed final consumption expenditures incurred by households, NPISHs, and government on individual goods and services and final consumption expenditure of government on collective goods and services.

2. Proposed additional experimental headings

1. Users' demand for goods and services PPPs.
 - **Goods (9290000)** - 87 BHs
 - Covering all goods making up GDP (not just HHC)
 - Current proposals include 'mixed' BH (including some services as well), such as construction (3 BHs), imports and exports of good and services.
 - **Services (9300000)** - 72 BHs
 - Covering all services making up GDP (not just HHC)
 - Medical and pharmaceutical goods in Ind. Gov. treated as services (3 reference BHs)
 - Both headings would be estimated **for publication**

Additional non-hierarchical headings (1)

2. For the purpose of validation **(not for publication)**

- **Public sector wages (9310000)** – aggregate of:
 - i. Compensation of employees - Ind. Hth. Govt (1302211)
 - ii. Compensation of employees - Ind. Edu. Govt (1304211)
 - iii. Compensation of employees - Coll. Govt (1401111)
- **Construction wages (9320000)** - aggregate of:
 - i. Residential buildings - Labor (1501211.03)
 - ii. Non-residential buildings – Labor (1501221.03)
 - iii. Civil engineering works – Labor (1501231.03)

3. Discussion and regional inputs

- Expect **no major changes** to the current classification for ICP2024.
- **Adoption of COICOP18*** (and to a lesser extent SNA25) for the next cycle will require updates to the ICP classification at all levels below main aggregates
- Contributions from RIAs on current aggregation mapping
 - Approach of ASI and EUO with goods and services PPPs.
- Complete aggregation mapping matrix is included in the ICP2024 Data Submission format.
